The Veterinary Officer reported that SUNDAY PROSPECT (FR), unplaced, trained by Karl Burke, finished lame left fore.





## Race 2 - 2:30pm.

## THE WATCH RACING UK TODAY JUST £10 HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (DIV I)

The Stewards gave permission for BIG RED trained by Rebecca Bastiman, to be mounted on the course and go early to post, for ANDAZ trained by Marjorie Fife, to be mounted on the course and for LE DELUGE (FR) trained by Micky Hammond to go early to post.

Rebecca Bastiman, the trainer of BIG RED, unplaced, reported that the filly was unsuited by the going which was good to firm and in her opinion, was too quick for BIG RED.

Jason Hart, the rider of THELLO, unplaced, reported that the gelding was denied a clear run 1 furlong out.

## Race 3 - 3:00pm.

## THE WATCH RACING UK TODAY JUST £10 HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (DIV II)

The Stewards held an enquiry into the use of the whip by B.A. Curtis, the rider of GRANDEST, placed second, from 1 ½ furlongs out. Having heard his evidence and viewed recordings of the race, they found him in breach of Schedule (B)6 Part 2 in that he had used his whip above the permitted level. The Stewards suspended Curtis for 2 days as follows: Sunday 31 July 2016 and Monday 1 August 2016.

The Stewards held an enquiry into possible interference approaching the 2furlong marker. Having heard their evidence and viewed recordings of the race they found that TABLE MANNERS, unplaced, ridden by Hollie Doyle, had interfered with OCEANELLA (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Jordan Vaughan. The Stewards found Doyle in breach of Rule (B)54.1 and guilty of careless riding in that TABLE MANNERS had manoeuvred into a gap and moved OCEANELLA (IRE) off an intended line. They cautioned her as to her future conduct in races.

The Starter reported that KYLLINI, trained by Marjorie Fife, was unruly behind the stalls and withdrawn. The trainer's attention was drawn to the restriction incurred under Rule (B)44 and informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

Marjorie Fife, the trainer of KYLLINI, had obtained prior permission from the BHA to run the filly partially shod. Additionally, the Stewards gave permission for KYLLINI to be mounted on the course, and for LORD ROB trained by David Thompson to go early to post.

## THE HIGH DEFINITION ON RACING UK HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Jacob Butterfield, the rider of ROARING RORY, unplaced, reported that the gelding hung right under pressure.

The Stewards gave permission for KIWI BAY trained by Michael Dods, to go early to post.

## THE SKY BET GO-RACING-IN-YORKSHIRE SUMMER FESTIVAL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

The Stewards gave permission for SAVANNAH BEAU trained by Marjorie Fife, to go early to post.

The Stewards considered the apparent improvement in form of the winner, RED TYCOON (IRE), ridden by Graham Gibbons and trained by David Barron, compared with its previous run at York on 11 June 2016 where the gelding finished 15 of 19, beaten by 13 ¾ lengths. They noted the explanation from the trainer's representative that the gelding was better suited by the faster ground on this occasion. They ordered RED TYCOON (IRE) to be routine tested.

## Race 7 - 5:20pm.

### THE REDCAR CRICKET CLUB FILLIES' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

The Starter reported that GLEAMING GIRL, trained by David Simcock, was unruly in the stalls and withdrawn. The trainer's attention was drawn to the restriction incurred under Rule (B)44 and informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

### Race 8 - 5:50pm.

## THE GO RACING IN YORKSHIRE FUTURE STARS APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

The Stewards held an enquiry into the use of the whip by Patrick Vaughan, the rider of INGLEBY HOLLOW, placed second, from inside the 3 furlong marker. Having heard his evidence and viewed recordings of the race, they found him in breach of Schedule (B)6 Part 2 in that he had used his whip above the permitted level. The Stewards suspended Vaughan for 2 days as follows: Sunday 31 July and Monday 1 August 2016.

The Stewards considered the apparent improvement in form of the winner, MIDNIGHT WARRIOR, ridden by Rowan Scott and trained by Ron Barr, compared with its previous run at Doncaster on 12 June 2016 where the gelding finished eighth of ten, beaten by 27 lengths. They noted the trainer's explanation that the gelding was suited by the quicker ground on this occasion. They ordered MIDNIGHT WARRIOR to be routine tested.

The Veterinary Officer reported that CELTIC POWER, unplaced, trained by Jim Goldie, had lost a left fore shoe.
