THE PLAY CORAL "RACING-SUPER-SERIES" FOR FREE MARES' HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for HEURE DE GLOIRE (FR) to go early to post and for PERFECT MYTH to wear a red hood to post.

The performance of GRIVETANA (FR) which started favourite and finished sixth, was considered. The representative of Paul Nicholls explanation that the mare was unsuited by the going which was officially described as Good to Soft, Soft in places, but changed to Soft following this race, and would prefer better ground was noted. GRIVETANA (FR) was routine tested.

Following the race, Harry Skelton reported that PETTICOAT LUCY (IRE), which was pulled up, stopped quickly and the Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of the mare failed to reveal any abnormalities.
