Race 1 - 4:20pm.

THE LADBROKES FOOTBALL ACCA BOOSTY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

The sponsorship in relation to CAPELLA FELLA (IRE) trained by Sarah Hollinshead did not comply with the Sponsorship Code of Conduct. Hollinshead was warned as to her responsibility to ensure that the

correct sponsorship is carried.

Following the race, Laura Coughlan reported that BROWN EYES BLUE (IRE), placed fourth, lugged left-handed in the home straight.

Race 2 - 4:50pm.

THE BOMBARDIER BRITISH HOPPED AMBER BEER CLAIMING STAKES (CLASS 6)

John James Feane was fined £140 as the record of vaccinations in the passport of BILLYFAIRPLAY (IRE) did not comply with the Rules of Racing.

Approaching the final furlong, BILLYFAIRPLAY (IRE), placed second, lugged left-handed, slightly interfering with BARBAROSA (IRE), placed fourth, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of BILLYFAIRPLAY (IRE).

Following the race, Georgia Dobie reported that OBERYN MARTELL, placed fifth, was outpaced throughout.

Race 3 - 5:20pm.

THE BETWAY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for KLOPP to go early to post.

Following the race, David Probert reported that BLACK ISLE BOY (IRE), placed fifth, hung badly left-handed in the home straight, Jimmy Quinn reported that CAPTAIN POWER (IRE), unplaced, jumped awkwardly from the stalls.

Race 4 - 5:50pm.

THE BETWAY CONDITIONS STAKES (CLASS 2) (All-Weather Championships Fast-Track Qualifier)

The performance of RAYMOND TUSK (IRE) which started favourite and finished fourth, was considered. The representative of Richard Hannon could offer no explanation for the colt's performance other than he had ran flat following a busy campaign.

Race 5 - 6:20pm.

THE BETWAY LIVE CASINO HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for KASER (IRE) to wear a hood in the parade ring only.

Race 6 - 6:50pm.

THE BETWAY MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 5)

LONGSIDER (IRE), trained by David Lanigan, was declared a non-runner in this race at 9:10 am. Lanigan

was fined £500 as he had made the colt a non-runner after 9am of the day of racing, without an acceptable reason.

Following the race, Hollie Doyle reported that SHARNEY, placed fourth, ran in snatches, Kieran O'Neill reported that SYDNEY SIREN, unplaced, ran green.

Race 7 - 7:20pm.

THE £BETYOURWAY AT BETWAY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Upon leaving the stalls, HE'S OUR STAR (IRE), unplaced, jumped left-handed, bumping BORN TO REASON (IRE), placed fourth, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

An enquiry was held to consider the placings in this race after interference approximately one furlong out when the winner, TRAVELLER (FR), ridden by Cam Hardie, lugged briefly left-handed before being quickly corrected, causing THUNDEROAD, placed second, ridden by Shane Kelly, to have to switch for a run. The Stewards considered that the interference had not improved TRAVELLER (FR)'s placing as he was eased on the run to the line, finishing half a length ahead of the second. The interference was found to be accidental due to Hardie's immediate correction.

The performance of HE'S OUR STAR (IRE) which started joint-favourite and finished unplaced, was considered. The representative of Ali Stronge's explanation that the gelding had ran too freely in a first time visor was noted. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of HE'S OUR STAR (IRE) during routine testing failed to reveal any abnormalities.
