Race 1 - 1:27pm.**THE FIND MORE BIG DEALS AT BETUK AMATEUR JOCKEYS' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for BOOM THE GROOM (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start and go early to post.

BOOM THE GROOM (IRE), drawn 2, anticipated the start and accelerated the gate at the same moment as the race had been started, thereby enabling the gelding to break quickly. Being satisfied that it was not caused through a faulty action of the starting stalls, no further action was taken.

Race 2 - 1:57pm.**THE BEST RACING ODDS GUARANTEED AT BETMGH HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)**

John Egan, the rider of ORANGE ROSETTA, unplaced, had appeared to stop riding shortly before the winning post to be beaten a neck for fifth place. After being interviewed and shown recordings of the incident, Egan was suspended for 1 day for failing to take all reasonable and permissible measures to obtain the best possible placing on a horse that could have finished fifth.

Leaving the stalls, TALKING RUBBISH, placed fourth, jumped quickly right-handed, hampering UNAVAILABLE, placed third, and TEN O'CLOCK (IRE), placed second, but after viewing a recording of the incident it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, Shane Kelly reported that TALKING RUBBISH, placed fourth, jumped badly right-handed leaving the stalls and Trevor Whelan reported that ROSADILLY, placed fifth, hung right-handed.

Race 3 - 2:27pm

THE BET £10 GET £40 AT BETMGM HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

The performance of ALJEZUR (IRE), which started favourite and finished fifth, was considered. Luke Dace could offer no explanation for the colt's performance.

Race 4 - 2:57pm.

THE BOOST YOUR ACCA-FENWA WITH BETUK CLASSIFIED STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for SAVANNAH SMILES (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start and be mounted in the chute and UNIVERSAL GRACE to be mounted in the chute.

Following the race, Alistair Rawlinson reported that FURNICOE (IRE), unplaced, hung right-handed off the home bend. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of UNIVERSAL GRACE, unplaced, during routine testing, revealed the filly lost its left-hind shoe.

Race 5 - 3:27pm.

THE BETUK. IT'S WHERE THE UK BETS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Race 6 - 3:57pm.

THE BETUK. HOME OF THE ACCA-FENWA RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (for horses in Bands C and D) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for GOWAREAGLE (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start and SERGEANTS LEGACY to go early to post.

Following the race, Joey Haynes reported that SERGEANTS LEGACY, unplaced, ran too freely.

Race 7 - 4:27pm.

THE ALWAYS GAMBLE RESPONSIBLY WITH BETUK CLASSIFIED STAKES (CLASS 6)

On the run to the line, STOPNSEARCH, placed second, shifted marginally right-handed onto an awkwardly placed IFTIKHAAR (IRE), placed fourth, causing that gelding's rider to have to take a check, but after viewing a recording of the incident it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of STOPNSEARCH.

Following the race, Marco Ghiani reported that BARBAROSA (IRE), placed third, reared as the stalls opened and was slowly away as a result.
