THE BOXING DAY HOSPITALITY AVAILABLE 'NATIONAL HUNT' NOVICES' HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 5)

The apparent improvement in form of the winner, JONGLEUR D'ETOILES (FR), which had never previously been placed, was considered. The explanation given by Neil Mulholland that the gelding has been steadily improving and having ran well on its previous appearance Mulholland thought JONGLEUR D'ETOILES (FR) was suited by, in his opinion, a weaker race on this occasion, was noted. JONGLEUR D'ETOILES (FR) was routine tested.

Following the race, the representative of Henrietta Knight reported that JIMMYJEROO, which was pulled up, ran too free having stepped up to 3 miles for the first time. The Veterinary Officer reported that SUPREME COMMANDER (IRE), unplaced, lost its right-hind shoe.

THE CHRISTMAS PARTIES AT WINCANTON RACECOURSE HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4) (Challenger Two Mile Hurdle Series Qualifier)

Following the race, Jonathan Burke reported that INTREPIDE SUD (FR), which was pulled up, ran too free. Philip Hobbs and Johnston White reported that SUNNINGHILL, placed fifth, was unsuited by the Soft going on this occasion and would prefer a quicker surface.

Following the race, Freddie Gingell reported that BUTTERWICK BROOK (IRE), which was pulled up, was never travelling; the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and had nothing to report. The representative of Joe Tizzard reported that MOONLIGHT ARTIST, which was pulled up, made a mistake at the first fence in the home straight on the second circuit and was never travelling thereafter.

THE BUY BOXING DAY TICKETS NOW "JUNIOR" NATIONAL HUNT FLAT RACE (CLASS 5) (Category 1 Elimination) (GBB RACE)

Approaching the last set of wings, the winner, MARHABA PRINCE, shifted left-handed away from the whip before being corrected, giving a slight bump to PRECIOUS METAL (FR), placed second. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of MARHABA PRINCE.

Following the race, Sam Twiston-Davies reported that INTOSOMETHINGGOOD, unplaced, hung badly left-handed and Bryan Carver reported that TRUSTINTIMES, unplaced, ran too free.
