THE CHRIS & LOUISE FAIRBURN HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4)

The performance of ROYAL PRETENDER (FR), which started favourite and finished seventh of nine runners beaten 29 ½ lengths, was considered. Alan King's representative's explanation that the gelding never travelled, was noted. The Veterinary Officer examined ROYAL PRETENDER (FR) post-race and had nothing to report.

Following the race, Dylan Johnston reported that BELVEDERE BLAST (IRE), unplaced, never travelled; the Veterinary Officer reported that the gelding finished lame on its right-fore.

After two false starts, the start was effected successfully on the third attempt. However, having reviewed recordings of the false starts, the Starters were satisfied that no riders should be reported for contravening the starting procedures.

The winner, HEY DAY BABY (IRE), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Uttoxeter on 6 June 2024, where the filly was pulled up. It was noted that Jonjo & A.J. O'Neill could offer no explanation for the filly's improved form. HEY DAY BABY (IRE) was routine tested.

Following the race, Sean Bowen reported that UNWANTED ATTENTION (IRE), which was pulled up, made a bad mistake jumping the second fence in the home straight on the final circuit and was never travelling thereafter; the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and had nothing to report.
