<u>Race 1 - 4:55pm.</u> THE UNIBET SUPPORTING SAFER GAMBLING MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for LALIQUE to wear a red hood to post.

Approaching 2 furlongs out, LIEUTENANT LILY, placed second, stepped quickly right-handed away from the rider's whip taking LUMINOSO (IRE), unplaced, slightly off its intended line, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of LIEUTENANT LILY.





The performance of LUMINOSO (IRE) which started favourite and finished unplaced, was considered. The representative of Raphael Freire could offer no explanation for the filly's performance. LUMINOSO (IRE) was routine tested.

Race 2 - 5:30pm.

THE UNIBET 40,000+ LIVE STREAMED EVENTS RESTRICTED MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 5) (for horses in Bands B, C and D) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for both IRONIST (IRE) and LINEAR SPIRIT (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

The performance of DIANARINA (FR) which finished unplaced, was considered. David Menuisier could offer no explanation for the filly's performance. The Veterinary Officer examined DIANARINA (FR) post-race and reported the filly to be in season.

Following the race, Pat Cosgrave reported that LILAC WINE (IRE), unplaced, was slowly away and hung left-handed.

<u>Race 3 - 6:00pm.</u> THE UNIBET ZERO% MISSION HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV I)

Permission was given for CIOTOG (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 4 - 6:30pm.

THE UNIBET ZERO% MISSION HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV II)

Following the race, William Cox reported that RACING DEMON, unplaced, was slowly away. The Veterinary Officer reported that BLUEBOTTLE BLUE, unplaced, bled from the nose.

Race 5 - 7:00pm.

THE TRY UNIBET'S NEW SMARTVIEW RACECARDS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for both BLEWBURTON (IRE) and ORCHARD (FR) to wear a red hood to post. Permission was also given for KNIGHTS GOLD (IRE) to go early to post.

Following the race, Fred Daly reported that WARRNAMBOOL (GER), placed fourth, was slowly away; Callum Shepherd reported that JERSEY MAVERICK (IRE), unplaced, jumped sharply left-handed resulting in the gelding being slowly away and Trevor Whelan reported that SPLIT SILK, unplaced, was slowly away.

Race 6 - 7:30pm. THE TRY UNIBET'S NEW IMPROVED ACCA BOOSTS (LONDON SPRINT SERIES QUAL) HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)





Permission was given for FORO ROMANO (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

The Starter reported that QUEUE DOS was unruly in the stalls and was withdrawn at 7:30pm. J.S. Moore was informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

Race 7 - 8:00pm. THE UNIBET MORE EXTRA PLACE RACES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (London Sprint Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for LIOSA (IRE) to wear a red hood, go early to post and be mounted in the chute. Permission was given for both BLUE DAY and DANGER ALERT to wear a red hood to post and for EMINENCY (IRE) to be mounted in the chute.

Leaving the stalls, TWILIGHT MADNESS, unplaced, jumped left-handed at the same time as BLUE DAY, unplaced, jumped right-handed resulting in INTERVENTION, placed third, the winner LIOSA (IRE), TIGER TULIP, unplaced and THURSDAY'S CHILD, unplaced all becoming short for room for several strides, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

<u>Race 8 - 8:30pm.</u> THE INDUSTRY LEADING IN-PLAY MARKETS AT UNIBET HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Following the race, Edward Greatrex reported that BRODIE'S BOY (FR), unplaced, was slowly away and Thomas Greatrex reported that DETROIT LION (IRE), unplaced, never travelled. The Veterinary Officer reported that SYLLABUS (IRE), unplaced, bled from the nose.
