Race 1 - 5:45pm.

THE DINE IN THE HORIZONS RESTAURANT "CONFINED" APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (horses which have not won a race since 2024 Flat Turf Season)

Permission was given for YEOMAN to wear a red hood to post, for TOUCHWOOD (IRE) to go early to post, and for EDEN STORM (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and be mounted in the chute.

Following the race, Fred Daly reported that YEOMAN, unplaced, ran too free, and Ryan Kavanagh reported that AUTUMN FESTIVAL, unplaced, fly-leapt leaving the stalls causing it to be slowly away.

Race 2 - 6:15pm. THE PLAY AT THE RACES STABLEDUEL NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for CARRADOS (IRE) and HAVANA'S DREAM to wear a red hood to post.

The raceday privilege request for OUR PLANET (IRE), trained by Clive Cox, to go early to post was late being submitted. Cox was warned as to his responsibility to ensure that all raceday privilege requests are submitted by 1pm on the day before racing.





Race 3 - 6:45pm. THE DOWNLOAD THE AT THE RACES APP MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for DUBAI BEACH (IRE), and TEMPEST STAR (IRE) to wear a red hood to post, and for PIDDIE'S PEARL to go early to post.

An enquiry was held to consider interference shortly after the start involving DUBAI BEACH, unplaced, ridden by Charlie Bennett, A DAY IN BLOOM (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Connor Planas, and PIDDIE'S PEARL, unplaced, ridden by Rhys Clutterbuck. The interference was found to be accidental as DUBAI BEACH shied quickly left-handed away from the free running PIDDIE'S PEARL, leaving A DAY IN BLOOM (IRE) short of room.

Race 4 - 7:15pm.

THE SKY SPORTS RACING SKY 415 HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

MEHMO (IRE), trained by Michael Attwater, failed to enter the Parade Ring. Attwater's representative explained that the rider had been last to weigh out, and that she had saddled as quickly as she could but she was the only member of staff present. Her explanation was accepted, and Attwater was reminded of his responsibility to ensure that horses should be in the Parade Ring before the signal to mount is given.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that DUE DATE, placed fifth, lost its right-fore shoe, and Elle-May Croot reported that MAY REMAIN, placed second, hung right-handed.

Race 5 - 7:45pm. THE SKY SPORTS RACING VIRGIN 535 HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

RAZZO ITALIANO (IRE) was disqualified and the placings revised as follows: First, FINE PRINT (IRE); Second, SOPHAR SOGOOD (IRE); Third, TAZAMAN; Fourth, MAN OF RIDDLES (USA); Fifth, CHEF DE TROUPE (FR). After being interviewed, the rider was suspended for 3 days and was not entitled to a riding fee.
