Race 1 - 2:10pm

THE WILLIAM HILL EPIC BOOST HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for SON OF MAN (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 2 - 2:45pm.

THE HALLGARTEN & NOVUM WINES / BRITISH EBF NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for CARRADOS (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Approximately 3 furlongs from the line, for a prolonged period of time, a free running THE OUTLAW (IRE), unplaced, became short of room between the runners; BILLBOARD STAR, placed third, which was lugging left-handed; and RARE CHANGE (IRE), unplaced, which was hanging right-handed, resulting in the three horses making contact, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of BILLBOARD STAR.

Race 3 - 3:20pm.

THE WILLIAM HILL LENGTHEN YOUR ODDS SELLING STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for COILED (IRE) to go early to post, wearing a red hood; and for HETTIE JACK to wear a red hood to post.

COILED (IRE) unseated Charles Bishop on the way to post and the gelding was then led to post, resulting in this race being late off. Having been checked by the Doctor at the start, Bishop was deemed fit to race.

Inside the final ½ furlong, I LOVE DAD (IRE), placed third, lugged left-handed, causing ASHEN GLOW (IRE), placed fourth, to shy away to the left and give a bump to COILED (IRE), placed second, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of I LOVE DAD (IRE).

An enquiry was held to consider why CLAY SHOVELER, trained by David Evans, was mounted in the saddling boxes. After being interviewed, the representative of David Evans's explanation that due to the horse's behaviour they had taken it into the saddling box to mount, and that he was unaware of the rule that horses may not be mounted in the saddling boxes, was noted. The representative was asked to remind Evans that horses may not be mounted in the saddling boxes or in the stables.

Race 4 - 3:55pm.

THE WEATHERBYS / BRITISH EBF AGNES KEYSER FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)

Permission was given for BEELEY to wear a red hood to post and to be mounted in the chute; and for BOLSENA, NAKHEEL (FR) and STRUTTING to all wear a red hood to post.

Race 5 - 4:30pm.

THE ROD GASKIN GARDEN MACHINERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for YORKINDNESS to go early to post, the mare also wore earplugs which were removed at the start.

An enquiry was held to consider interference shortly after the start involving, ALRIGHT SUNSHINE (IRE), placed fourth, ridden by Darragh Keenan; the winner, TENERIFE SUNSHINE, ridden by James Doyle; HEDONISTA (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Tom Marquand; and CRESCENT LAKE, placed third, ridden by Tom Queally. Queally was suspended for 2 days for careless riding as he allowed his mount to shift left-handed leaving insufficient room for ALRIGHT SUNSHINE (IRE), TENERIFE SUNSHINE, and HEDONISTA (IRE), who were racing on his inside and became tight for room as a result.

Following the race, Kieran Shoemark reported that FLEURMAN (IRE), unplaced, was never travelling.

Race 6 - 5:05pm.

THE WILLIAM HILL TAPSTER STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)

Permission was given for DEAUVILLE LEGEND (IRE), PASSION AND GLORY (IRE) and THREE PRIESTS (JPN) to all wear a red hood to post.

Race 7 - 5:40pm.

THE RACEHORSE SHARES FROM £45 AT racingclub.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for CHANGE SINGS (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and go early to post, wearing a red hood; for EMINENCY (IRE) to be mounted in the chute; and for RHYTHM N HOOVES to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, George Downing reported that CHANGE SINGS (IRE), unplaced, ran flat; and Hollie Doyle reported that RHYTHM N HOOVES, placed fifth, was bumped leaving the stalls.
