Race 1 - 1:55pm.**THE FIND MORE BIG DEALS AT BETUK HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)**

Following the race, Ben Robinson reported that BARLEY (IRE), placed second, was denied a clear run on several occasions from 2 furlongs out.

Race 2 - 2:30pm.**THE BEST RACING ODDS GUARANTEED AT BETMG M NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)**

Permission was given for TERRATINO FIRE to wear a red hood to the start and to be mounted in the chute.

Race 3 - 3:05pm.**THE BETUK. HOME OF THE ACCA-FENWA HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)**

Permission was given for YORKSHIRE (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start; for MONDAMMEJ to go early wearing a red hood to the start; for SPARKLING RED (IRE) to be led early to post.

Approaching the final furlong SECRET GUEST, placed fourth, edged slightly right-handed carrying MONDAMMEJ, placed second, marginally off its intended line which in turn caused SPARKLING RED

(IRE), unplaced, to be crowded for room on the rail and to be checked. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and had not improved the placing of SECRET GUEST.

Following the race, Oisin Orr reported that DARE TO HOPE (IRE), unplaced, was denied a clear run approaching the final furlong. Paul Mulrennan reported that SPARKLING RED (IRE), unplaced, suffered interference approximately a furlong out.

Race 4 - 3:40pm.

THE BEST RACING ODDS GUARANTEED AT BETMGH HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

An enquiry was held to consider the unruly behaviour of VINDOBALA (IRE) which had refused to race. Sam England was interviewed and shown recordings of the incident. As the mare had also refused to race at Musselburgh on 25 July 2023, England was informed that any future similar behaviour from VINDOBALA (IRE) may result in the horse being reported to the Head Office of the British Horseracing Authority.

Race 5 - 4:15pm.

THE BET £10 GET £40 AT BETMGH RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (for horses in Bands B, C and D) (GBB RACE)

Following the race, Adam Farragher reported that PELISSANNE (FR), placed fourth, was slowly away.

Race 6 - 4:45pm.

THE ALWAYS GAMBLE RESPONSIBLY WITH BETUK NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Following the race, Cam Hardie reported that CARADONNA, unplaced, was never travelling.

Race 7 - 5:15pm.

THE BETUK. IT'S WHERE THE UK BETS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV I)

Permission was given for MURBIH (IRE) and PEPSI CAT (IRE) to both wear a red hood to the start; for NEWYORKSTATEOFMIND to go early to post.

Race 8 - 5:45pm.

THE BETUK. IT'S WHERE THE UK BETS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV II)

Following the race, Dale Swift reported that CAPTAIN'S BAR, unplaced, ran flat having ran 4 days previously; the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding during routine testing and had nothing to report.

Race 9 - 6:15pm.

THE STAY GOLDEN WITH BETMGH SAFER GAMBLING HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for DR RIO (FR) to go early to post and to be mounted in the chute.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approaching the final ½ furlong involving ABSOLUTE DREAM (IRE), placed third, ridden by Ethan Tindall and KODEBREAKER (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Tom Eaves. Being a 7lb claimer Tindall was accompanied in the enquiry by a senior rider. Tindall was suspended for 2 days for careless riding as he allowed his mount to drift left-handed without sufficient correction causing Eaves to be tightened for room and to take a check off heels.

Following the race, Graham Lee reported that DR RIO (FR), placed second, was denied a clear run approximately 1 ½ furlongs out. Zak Wheatley reported that FLAMING O'HARA (IRE), unplaced, was never travelling. P.J McDonald reported that ROGUE FORCE (IRE), unplaced, was denied a clear approaching the final furlong.
