Race 1 - 4:12pm. THE UNIBET MORE BOOSTS IN MORE RACES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Callum Shepherd, the rider of MILITRY DECLARATION (IRE), fell inside the final two furlongs. The Stewards wished to hold an enquiry with Shepherd, Tom Marquand, the rider of GRIGIO (IRE), unplaced, and Luke Morris, the rider of PABLO PRINCE, placed second, but Shepherd was unable to be interviewed owing to his injuries. As a result, the enquiry was adjourned.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that BOY GEORGE, unplaced, lost its left-fore shoe and that GRIGIO (IRE), unplaced, finished lame on its right-fore.

<u>Race 2 - 4:43pm.</u> THE UNIBET MORE EXTRA PLACE RACES NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV I) (GBB RACE)





Permission was given for YANKEE DUDE (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Passing the two-furlong marker, CY TWOMBLY (IRE), placed fourth, lugged sharply right-handed away from the whip, resulting in RATHMOY, unplaced, being steadied, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of CY TWOMBLY (IRE).

Approximately half a furlong out, CY TWOMBLY (IRE), placed, fourth, shifted right-handed away from the whip, before being corrected and in doing so took RATHMOY, unplaced, off its intended line, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of CY TWOMBLY (IRE).

Following the race, Trevor Whelan reported that WHY BECAUSE (IRE), unplaced, bronked upon leaving the stalls.

Race 3 - 5:15pm. THE UNIBET MORE EXTRA PLACE RACES NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV II) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for DETAIN (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 4 - 5:45pm.

THE TRY UNIBET'S NEW ACCA BOOSTS NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for NIGHTBIRD (IRE) and FORT AUGUSTUS to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Hollie Doyle reported that ROGUE ENDEVOUR (IRE), unplaced, was outpaced in the early stages, David Egan reported that BERNING HOT (IRE), unplaced, was restless in the stalls, Oisin Murphy reported that SWEET SONATA, placed fourth, was denied a clear run approximately one and a half furlongs out and Joe Leavy reported that HOFBURG, unplaced, ran too free.

Race 5 - 6:15pm.

THE UNIBET ZERO% MISSION FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for DAWN SKY, FOLLOW YOUR DREAM, KOKO BLUE and SCARLET PRINCESS to wear a red hood to post. SANDHILL DANCER wore ear plugs throughout the race.

ELECTRIFARHH, trained by Ed Walker, did not enter the Parade Ring due to the filly being difficult to saddle in the stables.

Halfway down the back straight, FOLLOW YOUR DREAM, unplaced, stepped quickly left-handed and in doing so, took REQUISITE (IRE), unplaced, off its intended line, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Race 6 - 6:45pm





THE UNIBET SUPPORT SAFE GAMBLING HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (London Mile Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for FALCON NINE to wear a red hood to post.

Exiting the back straight, GREEN POWER, unplaced, was forced to switch left-handed off the heels of ONE STEP BEYOND (IRE), unplaced, due to the pace slowing, which resulted in BEAUTY GENERATION (IRE), unplaced, when improving its position to the inside of GREEN POWER becoming short for room and having to be steadied by its rider, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, Hollie Doyle reported that BEAUTY GENERATION (IRE), unplaced, hung right-handed and Kieran Shoemark reported that FALCON NINE, unplaced, was slowly away.

Race 7 - 7:15pm. THE TED PALMER MEMORIAL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for TYKE (IRE) and SUPREME KING (IRE) to go to post early and for COMPLETED, HAT TOSS (IRE), D FLAWLESS (IRE) and ROBBO (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, William Cox reported that COMPLETED, unplaced, ran too free, Darragh Keenan reported that HAT TOSS (IRE), placed third, was denied a clear run just inside the final two furlongs and Alistair Rawlinson reported that TYKE (IRE), unplaced, hung left-handed.

Race 8 - 7:45pm. THE RACING TV HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for IRRELEVANT (IRE) to be mounted on the course and to go to post early, for BATAL DANDY (IRE) to be mounted on the course and for REACHING THE MOON to wear a red hood to post.

An enquiry was held to consider interference passing the two-furlong marker involving TWILIGHT TRUTH, unplaced, ridden by Trevor Whelan and MY CLEMENTINE (IRE), placed fourth, ridden by Finley Marsh. Whelan was suspended for 2 days for careless riding as he had shifted his mount left-handed when insufficiently clear of Marsh, causing his mount to be short of room and steadied for several strides.

Following the race, Jay Mackay reported that LA VERITE, placed third, was denied a clear run on several occasions from two furlongs out and Anna Gibson reported that ASPIRE TO GLORY (IRE), unplaced, hung left-handed.

THE TRY UNIBET'S IMPROVED BET BUILDER HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (London Sprint Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for LAGUNA BOY (IRE) to be mounted on the course.
