Race 1 - 1:10pm.

THE DUBAI NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)

Permission was given for OUTGATE to wear a red hood to the start.

The Starter reported that CAPTAIN'S BAR was unruly in the stalls and withdrawn at 1:11pm. Richard Hannon was informed that the colt could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.





Following the race, Oisin Murphy reported that AMERICAN STAR (IRE), which started second-favourite and finished unplaced, was restless in the stalls.

Race 2 - 1:45pm.

THE GODOLPHIN FLYING START ZETLAND STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 3)

Permission was given for both GOLDSPUR (IRE) and UNCONQUERABLE (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, the representative of Richard Hannon reported that DUKEBOX (IRE), placed sixth, was unsuited by the track on this occasion.

Race 3 - 2:20pm.

THE EMIRATES AUTUMN STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 3)

Permission was given for ALFLAILA to wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, Rossa Ryan reported that MR PROFESSOR (IRE), unplaced, ran too free in the early stages of the race and Oisin Murphy reported that IMPERIAL FIGHTER (IRE), placed second, hung left-handed under pressure.

Race 4 - 2:55pm.

THE DARLEY DEWHURST STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 1)

Permission was given for BAYSIDE BOY (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, Ryan Moore reported that GLOUNTHAUNE (IRE), placed sixth, stumbled leaving the stalls.

Race 5 - 3:35pm.

THE TOGETHER FOR RACING INTERNATIONAL CESAREWITCH HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2) (HERITAGE HANDICAP)

Permission was given for LIVE YOUR DREAM (IRE) to wear a hood in the Parade Ring only, for both GOOBINATOR (USA) and NICHOLAS T to go early to post, for both BUZZ (FR) and THEMAXWECAN (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and go early to post, for MANCINI, SNOWALOT (IRE), and SPANISH KISS to all wear a red hood to the start, for MARGARET DUMONT (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and wear a red hood to the start and for PLATFORM NINETEEN (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood. GREAT WHITE SHARK (FR) wore earplugs throughout the race.

MAKAWEE (IRE) unseated Kieran Shoemark on the way to the start. Having been examined by the Doctor and Veterinary Officer respectively, both were deemed fit to race.

The Stewards noted that passing the 2 furlong marker in a tightly bunched field, the rider of GOOBINATOR (USA), placed fourth, was forced to ease against the rail due to becoming tight for





galloping room.

Following the race, Graham Lee reported that ELYSIAN FLAME, placed fifth, was denied a clear run between 3 and 2 furlongs out. The Veterinary Officer reported that both SPEEDO BOY (FR), unplaced, and SUPAKALANISTIC (IRE), unplaced, were showing signs of post-race heat stress and that RESHOUN (FR), unplaced, was struck into on its left-hind. W.P. Mullins reported that FOVEROS (FR), unplaced, was unsuited by the Good ground on this occasion and would prefer an easier surface.

Race 6 - 4:10pm. THE DUBAI BRITISH EBF BOADICEA STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)

Permission was given for SHE DO to wear a hood in the Parade Ring only, for MOUNTAIN BRAVE to be mounted in the chute and the filly wore earplugs throughout the preliminaries which were removed upon arrival at the start.

Prior to this race, Stuart Williams was asked to explain why he was running QUEEN KAHLUA here at Newmarket on going described as Good, having declared the filly a non-runner also at Newmarket on ground with the same official description. The trainer stated that in their opinion, the ground was riding faster than described at Newmarket previously and that QUEEN KAHLUA would be better suited by today's ground.

Following the race, Oisin Murphy reported that TENAYA CANYON, placed sixth, stumbled in the dip.

Race 7 - 4:45pm. THE DARLEY STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 3)

Permission was given for both BARNEY ROY and TYSON FURY to wear a red hood to the start.

The raceday privilege request in relation to TYSON FURY, was late being submitted. Spencer was warned as to his responsibility to ensure that all raceday privilege requests are submitted by 1pm on the day before racing.

Following the race, Ryan Moore reported that KHARTOUM (USA), unplaced, was slowly away.
