THE TRY UNIBET'S NEW IMPROVED ACCA BOOSTS AMATEUR JOCKEYS' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for EL HIBRI (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 2 - 5:00pm.

THE UNIBET SUPPORTS SAFER GAMBLING NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)





Permission was given for CHERRY COBBLER to be mounted on the course.

Following the race, Callum Shepherd reported that MACEDONIAN (IRE), unplaced, was denied a clear run approximately one and a half furlongs out and Hollie Doyle reported that PINMONEY, unplaced, hung right-handed under pressure.

Race 3 - 5:30pm.

THE FREE BET WITH UNIBET'S BETBUILDER REBOUND MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV I) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for PURPLE RAINBOW to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Taylor Fisher reported that PENNY'S SPIRIT (IRE), unplaced, ran too free and Hollie Doyle reported that BLUE WONDER (IRE), placed second, hung left-handed under pressure.

Race 4 - 6:00pm.

THE FREE BET WITH UNIBET'S BETBUILDER REBOUND MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV II) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for I'LL GIVE IT A GO to wear a red hood to post.

The Starter reported that I'LL GIVE IT A GO was unruly in the stalls and withdrawn at 6:03 PM. James Owen was informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

Following the race, Nicola Currie reported that LADY ODETTE (IRE), unplaced, was slowly away and ran green and Luke Morris reported that SELENIC (IRE), placed second, was slowly away.

Race 5 - 6:30pm.

THE GET DAILY PRICE BOOSTS AT UNIBET HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for MORINDOO to wear a red hood to post, LIEGE (IRE) to be mounted on the course and to go to post early wearing a red hood and for CHERRY KING to be mounted on the course.

Race 6 - 7:00pm.

THE UNIBET ZERO% MISSION FILLIES' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for NEXT TRICK (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for PREFER THE SISTER (IRE) to go to post early wearing a red hood.

An enquiry was held to consider interference at the cutaway, involving ASHFORD HILL, placed fourth, ridden by Isobelle Chalmers and HEART OF THE CITY (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Tommie Jakes. Being a 7lb claimer, Chalmers was accompanied by jockey coach, George Baker. Chalmers was suspended for 2 days for careless riding as she switched her mount right-handed when insufficiently clear of HEART OF THE CITY (IRE), resulting in Jakes being forced right-handed off his intended line.





An enquiry was held to consider interference approaching the final furlong, involving the winner, GAIETY MUSICAL (IRE), ridden by Richard Kingscote, MIDSUMMER MUSIC (IRE), placed fifth, ridden by Tom Marquand, NEXT TRICK (IRE), placed third, ridden by Hollie Doyle. Kaiya Fraser, the rider of HELP ME RHONDA (IRE), was questioned and it was established that his mount had run onto the heels of MIDSUMMER MUSIC (IRE) and stumbled shortly before the incident had occurred and was not directly involved. Kingscote was suspended for 2 days careless riding as he allowed his mount to drift right-handed under a left-handed drive, resulting in MIDSUMMER MUSIC (IRE) becoming short for room and bumping and unbalancing NEXT TRICK (IRE).

Following the race, Sean Levey reported that ZEPPARELLA, unplaced, ran to free.

Race 7 - 7:30pm.

THE HAPPY 60TH BIRTHDAY PETER GEORGE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for ANT COLONY (IRE) and REPORTER to go to post early wearing a red hood, for SWEET FANTASTIC (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for MONTRACHET GIRL (IRE) to go to post early. MONTRACHET GIRL (IRE) also wore ear plugs throughout the race.

Following the race, Hector Crouch reported that REPORTER, unplaced, ran too free and Fred Daly reported that MINI MAC (IRE), unplaced, hung left-handed.

Race 8 - 8:00pm.

THE TRY UNIBET'S NEW SMARTVIEW RACECARDS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

It was noted that GRAY RAINBOW, placed fifth, lost its right cheekpiece approximately two furlongs out. The cheekpiece was inspected and as it was found to be in a serviceable condition, no further action was taken.

The apparent improvement in form of the winner, BRUCE BANNER (IRE), which had never previously been placed, was considered. Gary Brown's explanation that the gelding had benefitted the significant step up in trip, having had limited opportunities as a two year old and having been able to get cover and settle better on this occasion having run too freely previously.
