The performance of VENTARA, which was joint second favourite and finished last of the nine finishers, was considered. It was noted that the representative of Joe Tizzard could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance; the Veterinary Officer reported that VENTARA had lost its left-fore shoe.

THE AUTISM IN RACING HERE 28TH MAY HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4)

An enquiry was held to consider interference approaching the second last flight involving the winner, AMERICAN LAND (IRE), ridden by Brendan Powell, and MOUTARDE (IRE), placed second, ridden by Callum Pritchard. The interference was found to be accidental as AMERICAN LAND (IRE) had shifted marginally left-handed at the same time as MOUTARDE (IRE) had edged right-handed, causing them to make contact.

Following the race, David Noonan reported that PIRATES' TALE, which was pulled up, was never travelling.

THE COAST AND COUNTRY ESTATE AGENTS HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

The Veterinary Officer reported that KNOCKMOYLAN (IRE), placed third, was lame on its right-fore leg.
