When turning for home, THE LONG POINT (IRE), placed fifth, drifted slightly right-handed at the same time as IRIS DES ISSARDS (FR), placed fourth, was angled slightly left-handed, causing TEORIE (IRE), placed second, to become short for room, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

The performance of THE LONG POINT (IRE), which started favourite and finished fifth, was considered. The representative of Emma Lavelle could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance.

Permission was given for TACTICAL AFFAIR (FR) to wear a red hood to post.

After an initial false start, the start was effected successfully on the second attempt. However, having reviewed recordings of the false start, the Starters were satisfied that no riders should be reported for contravening the starting procedures.

The apparent improvement in form of the winner, TIME TO BITE (IRE), compared with its previous run at Exeter on 9 February 2025, where the gelding finished seventh of nine runners, beaten by 44½ lengths, was considered. It was noted that Chris Honour could offer no explanation for the gelding's improved form other than a comment that the gelding seems to find it's form in the spring.
