THE CURE LEUKAEMIA NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for ANCIENT TRUTH (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 2 - 4:15pm.

THE SKY BET FOR THE FANS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for SCOTTISH ANTHEM to go early to post and to be mounted on the chute.

Approximately 1 furlong out, ISLAND BRAVE (IRE), placed fourth, shifted marginally right-handed before being corrected by the rider, causing BERKSHIRE ROCCO (FR), placed third, to become slightly short of room. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

The winner, HOPE YOU CAN RUN (IRE), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Newmarket on 4 May 2024 where the gelding finished seventh of nine runners, beaten 13 lengths. It was noted that the representative of Charlie Johnston could offer no explanation for the gelding's improved form. HOPE YOU CAN RUN (IRE) was routine tested.

Following the race, Harry Davies reported that SCOTTISH ANTHEM, placed sixth, hung badly right-handed.

Race 3 - 4:45pm.

THE SKY BET MATCH5 HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for MAHBOOB (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

The performance of MAHBOOB (IRE), which started favourite and finished unplaced, was considered. The

representative of John and Thady Gosden could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance other than a report from Jim Crowley that MAHBOOB (IRE) stopped quickly. The Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and reported that the gelding bled from the nose.

Following the race, David Barron reported that BARYSHNIKOV, placed sixth, was unsuited by the Going, officially described as Good to Firm on this occasion, and would prefer a slower surface.

Race 4 - 5:15pm.

THE SKY BET BUILD A BET HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for FLYING SECRET, NOODLE MISSION (USA) and HAT TOSS (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for DOUBLE TIME and OUTRUN THE STORM (IRE) to go early to post.

Race 5 - 5:45pm.

THE SKY BET EXTRA PLACES EVERY DAY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)

Permission was given for JEHANGEER (IRE), WATCH MY TRACER (IRE) and WOODHAY WONDER to wear a red hood to post.

An enquiry was held to consider two incidents of interference approximately 1 furlong out involving WARM SPELL (IRE), placed fifth, ridden by James Doyle, GARFIELD SHADOW (IRE), placed fourth, ridden by Oisin Orr, THE COFFEE POD (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Hollie Doyle and WATCH MY TRACER (IRE), placed sixth, ridden by Callum Shepherd. The first incident was found to be accidental as WARM SPELL (IRE) shifted quickly left-handed away from the whip before being quickly corrected by Doyle, taking GARFIELD SHADOW (IRE) slightly off its intended line. In the second incident, Orr was cautioned for careless riding as he allowed GARFIELD SHADOW (IRE) to shift left-handed without correction, causing Doyle to have to switch THE COFFEE POD (IRE) right-handed and furthermore moving WATCH MY TRACER (IRE) off its intended line.

Following the race, James Doyle reported that WARM SPELL (IRE), placed fifth, was restless in the stalls and as a result was slowly away and Hollie Doyle reported that THE COFFEE POD (IRE), unplaced, ran too free.

Race 6 - 6:15pm.

THE SKY BET REQUEST A BET HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for PEPSI CAT (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and LIR SPECIALE (IRE) to be mounted on the chute.

Following the race, Kieran Shoemark reported that ISLE OF LISMORE (IRE), placed second, hung right-handed.

Race 7 - 6:45pm.
