Race 1 - 5:45pm.

THE ALAN WOOD PLUMBING & HEATING SUPPORTING WPCC "CONFINED" APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (For horses have not won a race since 2023 Flat Turf Season)

Permission was given for CHURCHILL ROSE (IRE) to wear a red hood in the preliminaries.

Inside the final half furlong, SISTERANDBROTHER, placed third, became tight for room in a tightly packed field with SHE'S A NOVELTY (IRE), placed fifth, causing SHE'S A NOVELTY (IRE) to become also short of room. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of SISTERANDBROTHER.

Following the race, Joe Leavy reported that SHE'S A NOVELTY (IRE), placed fifth, hung badly right-handed. Jonny Peate reported that SISTERANDBROTHER, placed third, was denied a clear run in the final half furlong. The Veterinary Officer reported that POLEMON, unplaced, had bled from the nose.

Race 2 - 6:15pm.

THE MJ&B PLASTERING SUPPORTS BB WITH LOVE NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for BRINDLEY (IRE), FIFTY NIFTY (IRE), AMPHIUS and SWORD to wear a red hood in the preliminaries.

Approaching the final furlong, SWORD, placed third, shifted quicky right-handed, causing MUTAAWID, unplaced, to take a precautionary check. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found

that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of SWORD.

Following the race, William Carver reported that PARKLAND (IRE), unplaced, hung left.

Race 3 - 6:45pm.

THE ANT MARKETING PROUDLY SUPPORTS WESTON PARK HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for ROARIN' SUCCESS to wear a red hood in the preliminaries, and for CABRILLO (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and go to post early.

Following the race, Pat Dobbs reported that PUMALIN PARK (IRE), unplaced, stumbled leaving the stalls. Jim Crowley reported that TRIP TO ROME (IRE), unplaced, stopped quickly. The Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and had nothing to report.

Race 4 - 7:15pm.

THE NAPOLEONS CASINO & RESTAURANT SUPPORTING WPCC HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for CALL TO ACTION (IRE) and SAVIOUR (IRE) to wear a red hood in the preliminaries.

Inside the final furlong, the winner, MICKLEY (IRE), shifted quickly right-handed before being corrected, moving JUNGLE MAC (IRE), placed third, off its intended line, which in turn caused LOVE BILLY BOY (IRE), placed fourth, to be bumped and moved off its intended line. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of MICKLEY (IRE).

Following the race, Hollie Doyle reported that SECRET BID, placed fifth, lugged right-handed under pressure. Robert Havlin reported that SAVIOUR (IRE), unplaced, ran too free. Shane Gray reported that CALL TO ACTION (IRE), unplaced, stopped quickly. The Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and had nothing to report.

Race 5 - 7:45pm.
