## Race 3 - 6:40pm. THE MEMORIAL RACE OF ROGER MARRIOTT HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for JENEVER to wear a red hood to the start and for ANTIPHON (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood.

### Race 4 - 7:10pm. THE LESLEY MATTHEWS MEMORIAL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for RAYAT (IRE), BIBENDUM, and NORTHFIELD LAKE (FR) to all wear a red hood to the start and for PARISIAC (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood.

The performance of DARK DREAMER, which started favourite and finished unplaced, beaten by 9 lengths, was considered. It was noted that the representative of Robert Cowell could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance on this occasion. The Veterinary Officer examined DARK DREAMER post-race during routine testing and had nothing to report.

Following the race, Ray Dawson reported that CAPTAIN CUDDLES (IRE), unplaced, slipped leaving the stalls causing the gelding to stumble, Ben Robinson reported that MATCH PLAY, unplaced, hung right-handed throughout and Pat Cosgrave reported that VINCE LOMBARDI, unplaced, hung left-handed from approximately 3 furlongs out.

### Race 5 - 7:40pm.

THE MAMMA MIA HERE I GO AGAIN "CONFINED" HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (For horses who have not won more than one race)

Permission was given for CURRUMBIN (IRE) to wear a hood in the Parade Ring only, for DEBORA'S DREAM (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start and for SUMMIT (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and go early to post wearing a red hood.

Following the race, Ben Robinson reported that SUMMIT (IRE), placed fifth, ran too free and slipped on the bend turning into the home straight and Ross Coakley reported that MR WONDERFUL, unplaced, also slipped on the bend turning into the home straight.

### Race 6 - 8:10pm. THE SAVE MONEY, MONEY, MONEY FIVER FRIDAY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for FORTNUM, IT'S NOT RISKY, and EMERALD CITY to all wear a red hood to the start.





Following the race, Ray Dawson reported that CORRALES (IRE), unplaced, ran too free. Dylan Hogan reported that FLAVOR, unplaced, was never travelling and the Veterinary Officer examined the filly post-race and had nothing to report.

## Race 7 - 8:40pm. THE WINNER TAKES IT ALL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (Jockey Club Grassroots Stayers Series Qualifier)

Scott Dixon was fined £80 as the sponsorship in relation to DEFENCE TREATY (IRE) did not comply with the Sponsorship Code of Conduct.
