Michael Bowen stated that in his opinion, the going was on the softer side yesterday, and having walked the course, he found the ground to be quicker today.

After an initial false start, the start was effected successfully on the second attempt. However, having reviewed recordings of the false start, the Starters were satisfied that no riders should be reported for contravening the starting procedures. In order to save time, and to prevent clashing with a premier fixture, permission was given for a flag start without the starting tape.
