Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that SKETRICK (IRE), which was pulled up, bled from the nose. James Bowen reported that STAPLE HEAD (IRE), placed third, slipped on the bend.

**Race 3 - 3:25pm.****THE HORIZON PARKING LOVES PERTH RACECOURSE HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4)**

The performance of LORD CONDI (IRE), which started favourite and finished eighth, was considered. Iain Jardine could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance and the Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination, during routine testing of LORD CONDI (IRE), failed to reveal any abnormalities.

On the stands bend, LORD CONDI (IRE), placed eighth, stumbled badly after clipping the heels of ON A PROMISE (IRE), placed sixth, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that LATE DATE (IRE), placed fifth, had been struck into and finished lame on its left hind.
