THE EXTECH CLOUD COMPUTING MARES' MAIDEN HURDLE RACE (CLASS 3) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for LADY D'ARBANVILLE to wear a red hood to post.

Race 2 - 2:20pm.

THE MAYO WYNNE BAXTER NOVICES' HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that LE FAUVE (FR), which was pulled up, had bled from the nose, that TACTICAL AFFAIR (FR), which was pulled up, bled from the nose and that ALIEN STORM (IRE), placed fourth, lost its left-fore shoe.
