Race 2 - 4:15pm. THE SKY BET FOR THE FANS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Tim Easterby had obtained prior permission from the BHA to run GEORGIE WOOSTER (IRE) partially shod.

Permission was given for BEYLERBEYI to wear a red hood to post.

Michael Dods was cautioned as ARKENSTAAR had arrived in the Parade Ring without its declared cheekpieces, which were then located and fitted to the gelding before going to the start.

Leaving the stalls, KALAMUNDA, unplaced, jumped right-handed, bumping ARKENSTAAR, placed second, which was crowded for room and in turn made contact with the hindquarters of MY HARRISON GEORGE (IRE), unplaced, unbalancing that gelding, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Passing the 1 furlong marker, the winner, ZOZIMUS (IRE), hung left-handed, slightly hampering TERRIES ROYALE, placed fourth, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of ZOZIMUS (IRE).

Following the race, the representative of Mark Walford reported that NAVAL ACADEMY, unplaced, was unsuited by the going which was officially described as Good to Firm, Good in places and would prefer a slower surface.

Race 3 - 4:45pm. THE EBF SKY BET SUNDAY SERIES FLYING FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)

Permission was given for MIDREAM (IRE), MIAHARRIS and RAGE OF BAMBY (IRE) to each wear a red hood to post.

Race 6 - 6:15pm. THE SKY BET REQUEST A BET HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)

Following the race, Oisin Orr reported that DARK VINTAGE (IRE), unplaced, moved poorly; the Veterinary Officer examined the colt during routine post-race testing and had nothing to report.

Race 7 - 6:45pm. THE SKY BET ACCA FREEZE FILLIES' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for both MAY BLOSSOM and EMILY POST to go early to post, for BELLA KOPELLA (IRE) and THE WAITING GAME to be mounted in the chute and to go early to post and for MARY THE PRIEST (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

The performance of A GIRL NAMED IVY (IRE), which finished unplaced, was considered. The representative of Michael Dods could offer no explanation for the filly's performance; the Veterinary Officer examined A GIRL NAMED IVY (IRE) post-race and had nothing to report.
