Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that MYSTICAL MARTIKA (IRE), which was pulled up, had bled from the nose.

Following the race, Kevin Brogan reported that SUPPORT ACT (IRE), which was pulled up, weakened quickly in the home straight. The Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race during routine testing and reported that the gelding had lost its left-hind shoe.

The performance of SCENE ONE (IRE), which started second favourite and was pulled up, was considered. The representative of Lucy Wadham could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance. The Veterinary Officer examined SCENE ONE (IRE) post-race during routine testing and had nothing to report.

Race 5 - 3:53pm.**THE JOIN RACING TV NOW HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 3) (Qualifier for The Challenger Stayers Hurdle Series Final)**

Permission was given for OFF THE JURY (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

The performance of GRAND GESTE (IRE), which started second favourite and was pulled up, was considered. Joel Parkinson could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance. The Veterinary Officer examined GRAND GESTE (IRE) post-race and had nothing to report.

Following the race, the representative of Adam Nicol reported that BOWLING BUDDY (IRE), which was pulled up, had made a respiratory noise. The Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race during routine testing and had nothing to report.

Race 6 - 4:28pm.**THE BET NOW AT racingtv.com HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 5)**

Permission was given for SHADY B to be mounted in the chute and wear a red hood to post.

The performance of SHADY B, which started second favourite and was pulled up, was considered. The representative of Clive Boulton-Brooks's explanation that the gelding had made a respiratory noise was noted. The Veterinary Officer examined SHADY B post-race and had nothing to report.



Following the race, Philip Armson reported that GIBBERWELL (IRE), which was pulled up, never travelled, the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and had nothing to report.

Race 7 - 5:00pm.

THE RACING TV FOR THE CHELTENHAM FESTIVAL MARES' HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4) (Go North Lady Buttons Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for CHOSEN HERO (IRE) to go early to post.

An enquiry was held to consider the circumstances surrounding an incident on the way to post, involving CHOSEN HERO (IRE), ridden by Miss Brodie Hampson and trained by Archie Watson. The Clerk of the Course, the Managing Executive, a member of the Ground Staff and Miss Hampson were interviewed and shown recordings of the incident. After hearing their evidence, a report was forwarded to the Head Office of the British Horse Racing Authority for further consideration.

The performance of HARD AS NAILS, which started favourite and finished unplaced, was considered. The representative of Fergal O'Brien could offer no explanation for the mare's performance.
