THE JUDDMONTE EBF RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 2) (for horses in Bands C and D)(EBF Qualifier) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for MANILA THRILLER to wear a red hood to post.

Race 2 - 2:10pm.

THE WILLIAM HILL RIPON HORNBLOWER EBF NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 2) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for HERB FENNEL (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Sam James reported that LOVAT SCOUT, placed sixth, became unbalanced inside the

final furlong.

Race 3 - 2:45pm.

THE WILLIAM HILL SILVER TROPHY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for SUPREME KING (IRE) to go early to post.

Approximately 2 furlongs out, the winner, GRANT WOOD (IRE), edged slightly left-handed at the same time as ROUNDHAY PARK, placed fourth, moved slightly right-handed, resulting in MINNESOTA LAD (IRE), unplaced, being crowded for room and his rider having to take a check. But after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of GRANT WOOD (IRE) or ROUNDHAY PARK.

Following the race, David Allan reported that DANZAN (IRE), unplaced, stumbled badly leaving the stalls and never travelled thereafter. Jack Gilligan reported that RAY VONN (IRE), unplaced, never travelled, the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding during routine testing and had nothing to report.

Race 4 - 3:20pm.

THE WILLIAM HILL GREAT ST WILFRID HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)

The performance of MR WAGYU (IRE), which finished unplaced, was considered. The representative of John & Sean Quinn could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance. The Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and had nothing to report.

Following the race, Dylan Hogan reported that RADIO GOO GOO, unplaced, hung persistently right-handed inside the final furlong, rendering him unable to ride out to the line. Joanna Mason reported that KITAI (IRE), unplaced, became unbalanced on the undulations, the Veterinary Officer examined the filly post-race and reported it was slightly lame on its right-hind.

Race 5 - 3:50pm.

THE WILLIAM HILL OFFERS PROPER PRICES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for SIGNCastle CITY (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for PARK STREET to be mounted in the chute and go early to post.

Following the race, Oisín McSweeney reported that ON THE RIVER, unplaced, stumbled just inside 3 furlongs out, resulting in him losing his right iron for several strides.
