Race 1 - 1:30pm. THE BRITISH EBF NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Following the race, William Buick reported that BACKSPIN (IRE), unplaced, was slowly away losing many lengths as a result. Sean Levey reported that SKELLIG ISLE, unplaced, was slowly away losing many lengths as a result.

Race 2 - 2:05pm. THE MOLSON COORS BEVERAGE COMPANY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (Jockey Club Grassroots Sprint Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for ACKLAM EXPRESS (IRE), LIL GUFF and JENEVER to wear a red hood in the preliminaries, and for ATALANTA'S BOY to go to post early.

Following the race, Luke Morris reported that CONCIERGE (IRE), unplaced, was slowly away. Saffie Osborne reported that HIERARCHY (IRE), unplaced, was repeatedly denied a clear run in the final 2 furlongs. Tom Marquand reported that FANTASY MASTER, unplaced, was denied a clear run 1f out. Rossa Ryan reported that MAHARAJAS EXPRESS, placed fifth, was denied a clear run 1f out. Richard Kingscote reported that he eased ACKLAM EXPRESS (IRE), unplaced, out of the running as he felt something was amiss with the gelding. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination found the gelding to have a small wound on its right hind fetlock. Michael Attwater reported that MARY OF MODENA, unplaced, was unsuited by the Good, Good to Firm in places ground on this occasion and would prefer a softer surface.

Race 3 - 2:40pm.

THE BRITISH EBF MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for CHARMING FELLOW and ROYAL OFFICER (IRE) to wear a red hood in the preliminaries.

Following the race, Tom Marquand reported that CASPIAN KING (GER), unplaced, was slowly away. James Doyle reported that CONSOLIDATION, unplaced, was denied a clear run.

Race 4 - 3:15pm. THE BOOK YOUR CORAL-ECLIPSE TICKETS NOW HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Following the race, Kaiya Fraser reported that WISPER (IRE), unplaced, was denied a clear run approximately 2f out. Luke Morris reported that BORN RULER, placed second, hung right-handed in the home straight. William Buick reported that GALLANT LION, placed fourth, was denied a clear run 1½ f out. The Veterinary Officer reported that MAPOGO, unplaced, had a cut on his right hind hock.





<u>Race 5 - 3:50pm.</u> THE STYLE AWARDS RETURN TO LADIES DAY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for TIMETOBENICE and SIGNALMAN (IRE) to wear a red hood in the preliminaries.

Race 6 - 4:25pm. THE STUART ROBERT ALAN WILLIAMS MEMORIAL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for MIRRORING (IRE), LUNAR STREETS (IRE), NORTHFIELD LAKE (FR) and LADY FLORA to wear a red hood in the preliminaries.

The Starter reported that DIVINE BREATH was unruly in the stalls and withdrawn at 4.26pm. Ralph Beckett was informed that the filly could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

Turning out of the back straight, LADY FLORA, placed fourth, stepped right-handed, giving a bump to MIRRORING (IRE), unplaced, which resulted in both runners becoming unbalanced for a number of strides. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of LADY FLORA.

Following the race, Robert Havlin reported that SAVIOUR (IRE), unplaced, ran too free. Oisin Murphy reported that LADY FLORA, placed fourth, hung right.

<u>Race 7 - 5:00pm.</u> THE RACING & MUSIC NIGHTS AT SANDOWN PARK HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (JOCKEY CLUB GRASSROOTS STAYERS SERIES QUALIFIER)

Permission was given for COCK AND BULL (IRE) to wear a red hood in the preliminaries.

Following the race, Richard Kingscote reported that ARCH LEGEND, placed fifth, stumbled leaving the stalls. Rossa Ryan reported that ALLONSY, placed third, stumbled leaving the stalls.
