Permission was given for MARZOCCO (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 2 - 6:30pm.

THE RACING WELFARE CLASSIFIED STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for TWISTALINE to go to post early.

The Starter reported that BELO HORIZONTE was unruly, broke out the stalls and was withdrawn at 6:34PM. Richard Spencer was informed that the gelding could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

Following the race, Frederick Larson reported that HEERATHETRACK, unplaced, was slow away and Jonathan Fisher reported that THE GREY BANDIT, unplaced, ran too free.

Race 3 - 7:05pm.

THE BETSI HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for NASIM to go to post early.

Entering the home straight, BRUNO'S GOLD, unplaced, shifted marginally left-handed, which caused BEAUTIFUL CROWN, placed fourth, to become short of room, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, Alistair Rawlinson reported that NASIM, placed second, was slow away and Frederick Larson reported that GEORGE MORLAND, unplaced, never travelled.

THE WEATHERBYS STALLION BOOK CHELMSFORD CITY CUP HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for WYVERN to be mounted on the course and for MEISHAR (ARG) and RIOT (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 5 - 8:05pm.

THE MINISTRY OF SOUND 2ND SEPTEMBER HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for ASK PETER (FR) to be mounted on the course, for TRUSTY SCOUT (IRE) to go



to post early and for TEAM ENDEAVOUR to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Jonathan Fisher reported that ULYSSES (GER), unplaced, never travelled.

Race 6 - 8:35pm.

THE GENTLEMEN'S NIGHT 30TH SEPTEMBER HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for GOT NO DOLLARS (IRE) to be mounted on the course, for THE WAITING GAME to be mounted on the course and go to post early and for STARJIK to go to post early.

The Raceday privilege request for THE WAITING GAME, trained by Jack Jones, to be mounted on the course and go to post early was not submitted. Mr Jones was warned as to his responsibility to ensure that all Raceday privilege requests are submitted by 1pm on the day before racing.

The performance of JUNGLE RUN (IRE), which started favourite and finished last of ten runners, beaten 12½ lengths, was considered. It was noted that the representative of Tom Clover confirmed the explanation from Jack Mitchell that the gelding was slow away and was unable to obtain a prominent position.
