Permission was given for ROBEAM (IRE) and TIGERTEN to wear a red hood to post.

Race 2 - 2:37pm.

THE BLTH NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for PLUTONIC (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

The Starter reported that TITUS THOR was unruly in the stalls and withdrawn at 2:37pm. Malcolm Saunders was informed that the gelding could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

Permission was given for MASTER ZACK to go early to post.

SABRIMENTO (IRE), trained by Brian Meehan, spread a plate on the way to the start. As the trainer had not indicated at declaration stage that the gelding should be withdrawn in the event of losing a shoe on the way to post, SABRIMENTO (IRE) ran without its left-fore shoe.

THE DRAGONBET - REAL BOOKMAKERS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for CONNIE'S ROSE to wear a red hood to post and for FARO DE SAN JUAN (IRE) to go early to post.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approximately half a furlong after the start involving CONNIE'S ROSE, unplaced, ridden by Tom Queally, MAHARAJAS EXPRESS, placed fourth, ridden by Ryan Kavanagh and REDREDROBIN, placed fifth, ridden by Charlie Bennett. Being a 7lb claiming apprentice, Kavanagh was offered the opportunity to be accompanied but declined. Gina Mangan, the rider of PUNCHBOWL FLYER (IRE), unplaced, was also interviewed but found not to be involved as the gelding had slipped independently. Queally was cautioned for careless riding as he allowed CONNIE'S ROSE to shift right-handed causing Bennett to switch REDREDROBIN left-handed before causing MAHARAJAS EXPRESS to be taken slightly off its intended line.

Following the race, Gina Mangan reported that PUNCHBOWL FLYER (IRE), unplaced, slipped approximately half a furlong after the start.
