#### Race 1 - 2:50pm. THE DOWNLOAD THE RACEDAY READY APP HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for WAKAI UMI (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for MELLYS FLYER to go early to post.

## Race 2 - 3:20pm.

# THE NEWSTEAM DELIVER NEWSPAPERS TO YOUR DOOR RESTRICTED MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 5) (for horses in Bands C and D) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for RHAPSODY IN BLUE to be mounted in the chute and go early to post; LIVEALITTLECRAZY (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood; RUST E GAL (IRE) to go early to post.

An enquiry was held to consider interference turning into the home straight involving IMOLA (IRE), placed fourth, ridden by John Egan, the winner, STATE FLAG, ridden by Daniel Muscutt and INTERTWINED (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Harry Davies. Egan was suspended for 2 days for careless riding as he switched right-handed giving a bump to STATE FLAG which in turn caused INTERTWINED (IRE) to become unbalanced. Billy Loughnane, the rider of CERVARO DELLA SALA, placed second, was also present in the enquiry but having heard the evidence of the riders, it was found that he was not involved in the interference.

## Race 3 - 3:50pm. THE FREE DIGITAL RACECARD AT raceday-ready.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for KRYSDANJORD (IRE) and FORGOTTEN TREASURE to wear a red hood to





post.

Following the race, Paddy Bradley reported that MANALI (IRE), unplaced, jumped awkwardly from the stalls.

## Race 4 - 4:20pm.

# THE DOWNLOAD THE RACECOURSE APP RACEDAY READY RESTRICTED NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (for horses in Bands B, C and D) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for BARONETTI (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

The winner, TATATEO (IRE), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Kempton where the gelding finished seventh of twelve, beaten by 10<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> lengths. James Ferguson's representative's explanation that the gelding benefitted from an inside trip on this occasion, was noted. TATATEO (IRE) was routine tested.

Following the race, Jim Crowley reported that FAR L'AMORE (FR), placed third, was unsuited by the downhill track.

## Race 5 - 4:50pm.

Permission was given for BEACH POINT (IRE) and AUSSIE STAR to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Trevor Whelan reported that NEWFANGLED (IRE), placed fourth, became unbalanced downhill.

#### Race 6 - 5:20pm. THE TIPS FOR EVERY RACE AT raceday-ready.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

GENESIUS (IRE), drawn 1, anticipated the start and accelerated the gate at the same moment as the race had been started. Being satisfied that it was not caused through a faulty action of the starting stalls, no further action was taken.

The performance of LETABA, which started third favourite and finished unplaced, was considered. The representative of Ed Dunlop's explanation that the gelding was unsuited by the downhill aspects of the track, was noted. The Veterinary Officer examined LETABA post-race and had nothing to report.
