<u>Race 1 - 2:20pm.</u> <u>THE RACING WELFARE SUPPORTING MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS NOVICES' HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4)</u> (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for BLUE IN THE WEST (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, the representative of Sara Bradstock reported that BATSMAN, which was pulled up, made a respiratory noise; and Adam Wedge reported that WOODYTHEWOODPECKER (IRE), placed third, jumped left-handed down the back straight.
