An enquiry was held to consider the fall of Miss Katie Powell, rider of NIGHT JET, approaching the final furlong. Fern O'Brien, rider of GOOD IMPRESSION, placed fourth, and Miss Powell were interviewed. Both riders were accompanied by senior riders. O'Brien was suspended for 10 days for careless riding as she allowed her mount to drift left-handed without correction, into the path of NIGHT JET, causing the gelding to clip the heels of GOOD IMPRESSION and fall.

Following the race, Isabel Williams reported that MOUNT WASHINGTON (IRE), unplaced, hung left-handed. Fern O'Brien reported that GOOD IMPRESSION, placed fourth, hung left-handed. Miss Eleanor Williams reported that COUP DE GOLD (IRE), placed second, hung left-handed.

Twiston-Davies was for suspended for 7 for careless riding as he allowed his mount to drift left-handed when insufficiently clear of GLYNN BRAE (IRE), causing Cobden to take a significant check and his mount to clip heels and stumble.

Following the race, James Best reported that HELPFUL, which was pulled up, ran too free. Sean Bowen reported that TRUST HOUSE (IRE), unplaced, hung right-handed.
