THE MANSIONBET WATCH & BET HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4)

The performance of SHORTCROSS STORM (IRE), which started favourite and finished eighth, was considered. Chris Honour explained that the gelding was unsuited by the Soft going which in his opinion was riding dead. His explanation was noted and SHORTCROSS STORM (IRE) was routine tested.

Following the race, Philip Kirby reported that HIDDEN COMMANDER (IRE), which was pulled up, made a respiratory noise. The Veterinary Officer reported that KARAKORAM, placed sixth, lost its left-fore shoe.
