THE SKY SPORTS RACING SKY 415 NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for BJORN IRONSIDE to wear a red hood to post.

Race 2 - 2:20pm.

THE AT THE RACES APP EXPERT TIPS FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Following the race, Greg Cheyne reported that BRECKENRIDGE, placed fourth, ran green.

Race 3 - 2:50pm.

THE SKY SPORTS RACING HD VIRGIN 519 NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for HIGH POINT (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Race 4 - 3:20pm.

THE CHAMPIONS DAY ON SKY SPORTS RACING HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for SEA EAGLE and AZAHARA PALACE to wear a red hood to post.

An enquiry was held to consider why Charles Bishop who was declared to ride CABINET OF CLOWNS (IRE) and was required to provide a breath sample had failed to arrive. The Clerk of the Scales and Breath Tester were interviewed. Having heard their evidence, the matter was forwarded to the Head Office of the British Horseracing Authority for further consideration.

Following the race, Hollie Doyle reported that AZAHARA PALACE, unplaced, hung left-handed on the first bend and Thomas Greatrex reported that NIGHT ARC, unplaced, never travelled. The Veterinary Officer examined NIGHT ARC post-race and had nothing to report.

Race 5 - 3:50pm.

THE AT THE RACES APP MARKET MOVERS MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for SIXTIES CHIC to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Kieran Shoemark reported that HALLROSE, unplaced, was slowly away.

Race 6 - 4:20pm

THE AT THE RACES APP FORM STUDY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV I)

Permission was given for HURTLE (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for MRS MEADER to be mounted on the course.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approximately two furlongs out involving MRS MEADER, placed fourth, ridden by Dylan Hogan and PRIDE OF HAWRIDGE (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Mollie Phillips. Hogan was cautioned for careless riding as he had switched his mount right-handed when insufficiently clear of PRIDE OF HAWRIDGE (IRE), causing Phillips to momentarily ease her mount.

Following the race, William Carver reported that CHARLIE ARTHUR (IRE), unplaced, was slowly away.

Race 7 - 4:52pm.

THE AT THE RACES APP FORM STUDY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV II)

Permission was given for ARENAS DEL TIEMPO to be mounted on the course and go to post early wearing a red hood.

Brett Johnson was fined £140 for doubly declaring MERRY MINISTER (IRE) to run in THE AT THE RACES APP FORM STUDY HANDICAP STAKES (DIV II) and THE CHAMPIONS DAY ON SKY SPORTS RACING HANDICAP STAKES at Windsor and the gelding ran in the latter race.

Following the race, Paddy Bradley reported that ARENAS DEL TIEMPO, placed third, hung left-handed under pressure.

Race 8 - 5:22pm.

THE BREEDERS CUP ON SKY SPORTS RACING HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for LAHINA BAY (IRE) to be mounted on the course and go to post early and for PHOENIX GLOW (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Approximately two and a half furlongs out, HAVEAGOBEAU, unplaced, stepped right-handed, which caused a free running LAHINA BAY (IRE), unplaced, to be taken marginally off its intended line, which resulted in LORD P, unplaced, to be short for room. Shortly thereafter, LAHINA BAY (IRE) stepped quickly right-handed, before being corrected by its rider, which tightened LORD P for racing room, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that HAVEAGOBEAU, unplaced, was struck into on its left-hind leg.
