Race 1 - 5:15pm. THE DOWNLOAD THE RACING APP 43 NOW NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

THE DRAGON KING (IRE) wore earplugs throughout the race.

Leaving the stalls, STORM CALL (IRE), placed second, jumped right-handed as SIEGEN (IRE), placed fifth, jumped left-handed causing them to make contact, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of STORM CALL (IRE).

<u>Race 2 - 5:45pm.</u> THE TRUST TRAILFINDERS WITH ALL YOUR TRAVELS, EBF NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for SOLAR EDGE to wear a red hood to post.

Approximately 2 furlongs out, the winner, APARAJEO (IRE), lugged sharply left-handed despite the rider's best efforts carrying SOLAR EDGE, unplaced, off its intended line and causing knock-on interference to ROKUNI (IRE), placed fourth, and VALSHARAH (IRE), unplaced, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of APARAJEO (IRE).

Race 3 - 6:20pm. THE THAMES NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV I) (GBB RACE)

BULLET POINT wore earplugs throughout the race and permission was given for UNDER SIEGE (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Daniel Tudhope reported that UNDER SIEGE (IRE), placed third, was slowly away and Trevor Whelan reported that ZAMBEZI DIAMOND, unplaced, hung left-handed.





<u>Race 4 - 6:50pm.</u> THE THAMES NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (DIV II) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for AMPHIUS to wear a red hood to post.

Race 5 - 7:20pm. THE FITZDARES SPRINT SERIES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (Windsor Sprint Series Qualifier)

Permission was given for ORMOLULU (IRE) to go early to post and be mounted on the chute.

<u>Race 6 - 7:50pm.</u> THE FEGIME DAY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for MACS DILEMMA (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood and be mounted on the chute and for ROGUE ENCORE to wear a red hood to post.

Hughie Morrison was fined £140 for doubly declaring MR MISTOFFELEES (IRE) to run in THE FEGIME DAY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) at Windsor and THE DOWNLOAD THE FITZDARES APP NOW HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) at Windsor, and the gelding ran in the latter.

Race 7 - 8:20pm. THE DOWNLOAD THE FITZDARES APP NOW HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for TRIBAL WISDOM (IRE) to wear a red hood to post and for EXPERT WITNESS to go early to post and be mounted on the chute and for NAP HAND (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood and be mounted on the chute.

Following the race, Tom Marquand reported that MR MISTOFFELEES (IRE), unplaced, stopped quickly and the Veterinary Officer examined the gelding post-race and had nothing to report.

Race 8 - 8:50pm. THE TRAILFINDERS, THE TRAVEL EXPERTS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for DUE TO HENRY to wear a red hood to post.
