Race 1 - 5:30pm.

THE C H SERVICES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Philip Kirby was fined £140 as the record of vaccinations in the passport of BAHKIT (IRE) did not comply with the Rules of Racing.

Franny Norton the rider of TROOP, placed second, was suspended for 2 days for using his whip above the permitted level from 2 furlongs out.

Approaching the final furlong, TROOP, placed second, hung quickly right moving CHARLIE'S BOY (IRE), placed eighth, off its intended line. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of TROOP.

Following the race, Franny Norton reported that TROOP, placed second, hung right under pressure. The Veterinary Officer reported that NINGALOO (GER), unplaced, was found to be lame left hind post-race.

Race 2 - 6:00pm.**THE DFE ELECTRICAL MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 5)**

Race 3 - 6:30pm.**THE FORD MEDIAN AUCTION MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 5)**

An enquiry was held into the running and riding of LA TRINIDAD, ridden by Paula Muir and trained by Roger Fell which was slowly away before staying on strongly to finish sixth of eleven beaten 8¾ lengths. The rider and the trainer's representative were interviewed and shown recordings of the race and the Veterinary Officer reported a post-race examination failed to reveal any abnormalities. The rider stated her instructions were that as the gelding had dwelt in its last two races, to get him settled and get him balanced and let him run his race. She added that LA TRINIDAD had developed a breathing problem and she felt it better to keep a hold of the gelding's head. The trainer's representative stated she was satisfied that the ride accorded with the instructions given. The Stewards found the rider and trainer had intentionally failed to ensure that their horse ran on its merits in that LA TRINIDAD appeared capable of reaching a challenging position before being intentionally never asked to do so. The matter was referred to the Head Office of the British Horseracing Authority and LA TRINIDAD was suspended from running for 40 days.

Following the race, Shane Gray reported that CHARMORE, unplaced, hung left.

Race 4 - 7:00pm.**THE SCE ELECTRICAL LTD HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)**

Permission was given for WILLOW BROOK and NORTHERN SOCIETY (IRE) to go to post early and for KYROC (IRE) to be mounted on the track and go to post early.

Following the race, Jamie Gormley reported that LORD OF THE GLEN, placed sixth, was denied a clear run in the final furlong. Andrew Breslin reported that KYROC (IRE), moved poorly throughout. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Race 5 - 7:30pm.**THE MOUNSEY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)**

Permission was given for MOLTEN LAVA (IRE) to go to post early.

1½ furlongs out, KEY CHOICE, unplaced, hung left at the same time as CALEVADE (IRE), placed sixth, edged right, causing MR COOL CASH, unplaced, to be checked. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of KEY CHOICE.

The performance of POETIC CHOICE which finished unplaced, was considered. The representative of K

Clarke could offer no explanation for the mare's performance. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of the mare failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Race 6 - 8:00pm.

THE GREENSLEEVES LAWN CARE TREATMENT SERVICES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for BREATHOFFRESHAIR and THE RETRIEVER (IRE) to go to post early.

Race 7 - 8:30pm.

THE GREENSLEEVES LAWCARE TREATMENT SERVICES CLASSIFIED STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for ELDELBAR (SPA) to be led to post early and for RAFFLE KING (IRE) to be mounted on the track and go to post early.

The Starter reported JEFFREY HARRIS was the subject of a third criteria failure. Jim Goldie was informed that the gelding could not run until the day after passing a stalls test. As it was the second occasion within the previous 12 months that JEFFREY HARRIS had been reported, a further report within the same period would mean the gelding would be prevented from having a stalls test for 6 months.

On leaving the stalls, PICKS PINTA, unplaced, jumped right as RAFFLE KING (IRE), unplaced, jumped left causing interference to DEEDS NOT WORDS (IRE), unplaced. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

On leaving the stalls, ROCKLEY POINT, placed fourth, jumped left interfering with LOULIN, placed fifth, and MIXED UP MISS (IRE), unplaced. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of ROCKLEY POINT.

The performance of RAFFLE KING (IRE) which finished unplaced, was considered. The representative of Julia Brooke explained that the gelding may have been unsuited by the removal of a visor on this occasion. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination failed to reveal any abnormalities.
