Race 1 - 2:05pm. THE bettingsites.co.uk FAIR BETTING SITES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for BEYLERBEYI to wear a red hood in the preliminaries.

Inside the final furlong, YOUNG FIRE (FR), placed second, lugged quickly left causing the weakening DOUGIES DREAM (IRE), placed third, to be crowded for room. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of YOUNG FIRE (FR).

Race 2 - 2:40pm. THE bettingsites.co.uk SAFE BETTING SITES NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)





Permission was given for PAGAN SUN (FR) to wear a red hood in the preliminaries.

Race 3 - 3:15pm. THE bettingsites.co.uk NEW BETTING SITES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for CAMBRIA LEGEND (IRE) to wear a red hood in the preliminaries, and for NAP HAND (IRE) to go to post early.

Inside the final 2 furlongs, CHATURANGA (IRE), placed fifth, hung quickly right-handed for one hit, causing MASEKELA (IRE), placed third, to be crowded for room and the rider have to take a precautionary check. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Approaching the final furlong, STRESSFREE (FR), placed second, lugged quickly right-handed taking NAP HAND (IRE), placed fourth, briefly off its intended line, which in turn took CHATURANGA (IRE), placed fifth, slightly off its intended line. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of STRESSFREE (FR).

Following the race, Mark Winn reported that STRESSFREE (FR), placed second, was denied a clear run 2f out.

Race 4 - 3:50pm.

THE bettingsites.co.uk BETTING SITES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)

Permission was given for ALLIGATOR ALLEY to wear a red hood in the preliminaries, and for KYLIAN (IRE) to go to post early. MON NA SLIEVE (IRE) wore earplugs throughout.

Following the race, Mark Winn reported that ALLIGATOR ALLEY, unplaced, was slowly away.

Race 5 - 4:25pm.

THE AGM SAFETY LTD FILLIES' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for MISS ATTITUDE and ANGEL SHARED to wear a red hood in the preliminaries, and for BELLA KOPELLA (IRE) to go to post early.

<u>Race 6 - 5:00pm.</u> THE HOWARTH TIMBER AND BUILDING SUPPLIES FILLIES' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Approximately 2 furlongs out, BIPLANE (USA), placed fourth had to be checked after becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of INANNA (IRE), unplaced. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of BIPLANE (USA).

Inside the final furlong, Richard Kingscote, the rider of the winner BELLA TASLINA, struck RAPIDO GIRL, placed fifth, once over the nose with the whip, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was





considered to be accidental.

Approaching the winning line, ALSEEYERTHERE, placed second, edged marginally left at the same time as the winner BELLA TASLINA, moved marginally right causing the weakening RAPIDO GIRL, placed fifth, to become crowded for room and the rider have to take a precautionary check. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of any horse.

Following the race, Mark Winn reported that BIPLANE (USA), placed fourth, was denied a clear run 2f out.

Race 7 - 5:35pm. THE SUMMER SATURDAY SERIES AT DONCASTER HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for AMERICAN STAR (IRE) to go to post early.

The winner, KODI RED (IRE), appeared to show an improvement in form, compared with its previous run at Newbury on 25 June 2024, where the gelding finished eighth of nine beaten 8³/₄ lengths. It was noted that the representative of Darryll Holland could offer no explanation for the gelding's improved form. KODI RED (IRE) was routine tested.

Following the race, Richard Kingscote reported that MOKAATIL, unplaced, was denied a clear run approaching the line. Laura Coughlan reported that NAMMOS, unplaced, hung left-handed in the home straight.
