THE FOR ONLINE PHARMACEUTICALS VISIT mymedsuk.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

An enquiry was held to consider interference shortly after leaving the stalls when JUST RIGHT, unplaced, ridden by Dougie Costello, interfered with BALGOWLAH (IRE), placed seventh, ridden by Stevie Donohoe, which in turn interfered with PRAECEPTS (IRE), placed third, ridden by Luke Morris, which in turn interfered with DURATION (IRE), placed fourth, ridden by William Carver, which in turn interfered with RUM RATION, unplaced, ridden by Edward Greatrex. Costello was suspended for 4 days for careless riding as he had drifted left-handed from a wide draw, causing interference firstly by intimidation and subsequently by being insufficiently clear of BALGOWLAH (IRE), causing that gelding to shift left-handed onto an

already packing field on the inside.

Following the race, Shelley Birkett reported that SIR FRED (IRE), placed sixth, was never travelling. The Veterinary Officer reported that CATCH THE TIDE (FR), unplaced, lost its right hind shoe.
