#### THE DEWDROP WORCESTER STAY DRINK & EAT HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 5)

Prior to this race, Tim Vaughan's representative was asked to explain the reason why he was running CAPE ROBIN (IRE) here at Worcester on going described as Good, having declared the gelding a non-runner at Worcester on 17 August 2022 on ground with the same official description. Vaughan's representative stated that in their opinion, the Going on 17 August 2022 was slower than described, as it had rained during racing.

Following the race, Nick Scholfield reported that KABRIT (IRE), placed fourth, made a bad mistake at the second fence in the back straight in the final circuit and the Veterinary Officer reported that CAPE ROBIN (IRE), unplaced, had lost both of its front shoes.

## THE WORCESTER BOSCH 60 YEAR ANNIVERSARY HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 3)

The performance of SEA PRINCE, which finished placed fourth, was considered. Alex Hales' representative's explanation that the gelding appeared to be unsuited by the increase in grade from Class 4 to Class 3 was noted.

Following the race, Kielan Woods reported that GONE IN SIXTY, placed second, was hit on the leg by a shoe on the bend turning into the back straight and the Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of the gelding failed to reveal any abnormalities. Conor Ring reported that MONTAQEM (FR), unplaced, was never travelling and the Veterinary Officer reported that the gelding had lost its left fore shoe.
