The winner, INVICTUS ALLEN (FR), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at





Newton Abbot on 20 May 2024 where the gelding finished sixth of seven runners, beaten by 37 lengths. It was noted that the representative of Christian Williams could offer no explanation, other than the yard's runners are in good form at present. INVICTUS ALLEN (FR) was routine tested.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that SCALLOWAY CASTLE (IRE), unplaced, lost its right-hind shoe.

THE B3 WEALTH MANAGEMENT HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4)

The winner, ALLBETSOFF (IRE), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Carlisle on 28 June 2024 where the gelding finished sixth of fourteen runners, beaten by 17½ lengths. It was noted that the representative of Mark Walford could offer no explanation for the gelding's improved form on this occasion.

Following the race, Fern O'Brien reported that MADE FOR YOU, placed second, hung left-handed in the home straight.

Race 6 - 4:40pm.

THE BURTON ALBION FAMILY RACEDAY 28TH JULY HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 4)

Philip Kirby was asked to explain why he was running GOLFE CLAIR (FR) here at Uttoxeter on going described as Soft, having declared the gelding a non-runner at Uttoxeter on 9 July 2024 on ground with the same official description. The trainer's representative stated that there have been limited opportunities recently for GOLFE CLAIR (FR) and was therefore happy for the gelding to take its chance today.

Ben Pauling was asked to explain why he was running DEERSTALKER (IRE) here at Uttoxeter on going described as Soft, having declared the gelding a non-runner at Uttoxeter on 9 July 2024 on ground with the same official description. The trainer's representative stated that they had hoped the ground would have dried out better than it has and having brought DEERSTALKER (IRE) to the course and walked the track, they were happy for the gelding to take its chance today.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that IMPERIAL BEDE (FR), unplaced, lost its right-fore shoe.

Race 7 - 5:15pm.

THE UTTOXETER RACECOURSE CARAVAN AND MOTORHOME SITE HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 5) (DIV I)

On the approach to the first hurdle a free-running SQUARE DU ROULE (FR), placed fifth, clipped the heel of MAC BE LUCKY, which was later pulled up, and stumbled, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

On the bend leaving the back straight, CELLAR CLUB, unplaced, shifted right-handed making contact with the hindquarters of MAC BE LUCKY, which was later pulled up, causing both runners to become





unbalanced, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that BELLA CIAO, unplaced, lost its left-fore shoe.

Race 8 - 5:45pm.

THE UTTOXETER RACECOURSE CARAVAN AND MOTORHOME SITE HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 5) (DIV II)

Permission was given for RECORD ART (FR), TOTOWOLFE, and BUSHMILL BOY to all wear a red hood to the start and for MACKIE DEE (IRE) to be mounted in the chute.

The winner, WINDS OF FIRE (USA), appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Cartmel on 27 May 2024, where the gelding was pulled up. The explanation of the representative of Evan Williams that WINDS OF FIRE (USA) had benefitted from the reapplication of a Visor on this occasion was noted.
