Race 1 - 1:50pm.

THE QUEEN MOTHER'S CUP HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3) (FOR LADY AMATEUR RIDERS)

An enquiry was held to consider interference shortly after the start when DESERT RULER, unplaced, ridden by Miss Becky Smith, interfered with ARMANDIHAM (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Miss Harriet Lees, which in turn caused interference to the winner, MISTER BELVEDERE, ridden by Miss Sophie Dods. Miss Smith was suspended for 3 days for careless riding as she had allowed her mount to drift left, causing interference to ARMANDIHAM (IRE), which in turn gave a bump to MISTER BELVEDERE on the rail. Suspension dates will be notified by the Head Office of the British Horseracing Authority.

Following the race, Miss Laura Wilson reported that ALWAYS RESOLUTE, unplaced, banged its head on the stalls having removed the blindfold marginally early.

Race 2 - 2:25pm.

THE JCB HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)

Permission was given for SQUATS (IRE) to go early to post.

Following the race, Daniel Tudhope reported that SALATEEN, unplaced, anticipated the start, causing the colt to bang its head on the stalls and was slowly away. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of SALATEEN failed to reveal any abnormalities; Oisin Murphy reported that SQUATS (IRE), unplaced, ran too free.

Race 3 - 3:00pm.

THE SKY BET GRAND CUP STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)

Permission was given for DURETTO and MELODIC MOTION (IRE) to wear a hood in the parade ring.

Ryan Moore, the rider of the winner, MARMELO, was suspended for 2 days for using his whip without giving the colt time to respond in the final ½ furlong.

Race 4 - 3:35pm.

THE PAVERS FOUNDATION CATHERINE MEMORIAL SPRINT HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 2)

Permission was given for BESHAAAYIR to wear a hood in the parade ring and for BAMBINO LOLA to go early to post.

Following the race, Ryan Moore reported that SNAZZY JAZZY (IRE), unplaced, was never travelling.

Jamie Spencer reported that GREAT PROSPECTOR (IRE), unplaced, moved poorly throughout and Dane O'Neill reported that JAWWAAL, unplaced, was briefly denied a clear run in the final furlong. The Veterinary Officer reported that post-race examinations, during routine testing, of SNAZZY JAZZY (IRE) and GREAT PROSPECTOR, failed to reveal any abnormalities. The Veterinary Officer further reported that SOLDIER'S MINUTE, placed sixth, lost its left hind shoe; CITRON MAJOR, unplaced, bled from the nose and NEOLA, unplaced, was lame on its right fore.

Race 5 - 4:05pm.

THE ICE CO SUPPORTING MACMILLAN HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

TADAAWOL ran at York yesterday. The Veterinary Officer reported that a pre-race examination deemed the gelding fit to race.

The Starter reported that RADJASH refused to enter stalls. Ruth Carr was informed that the gelding could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

On the bend leaving the back straight, DARK INTENTION, placed fourth, shifted right at the same time as the free running CAPTAIN BOB (IRE), unplaced, shifted right, both causing the rider of GHAYYAR (IRE), placed sixth, to take back, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of DARK INTENTION.

Inside the final furlong, the winner, GIVE IT SOME TEDDY, lugged left slightly intimidating DESTROYER, placed third, who in turn shifted WAARIF (IRE), placed second, off its intended line but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of GIVE IT SOME TEDDY.

Following the race, Paula Muir reported that DUCK EGG BLUE (IRE), placed eighth, dwelt in the stalls.

Race 6 - 4:40pm.

THE REG GRIFFIN APPRECIATION ebfstallions.com MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 3) (PLUS 10 RACE)

Following the race, Ryan Moore reported that PINK FLAMINGO, who dead heated for fifth place, ran green under pressure.

Race 7 - 5:15pm.

THE JILL WILLOWS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for WEDIDDODONTWE to go early to post.

The sponsorship of Tom Queally, the rider of CLASSIC PURSUIT, did not comply with the Sponsorship Code of Conduct. Queally was warned as to his responsibility to ensure that the correct sponsorship is carried.

At the 1 furlong marker, BOGART, unplaced, hung badly right before being corrected, causing interference to CLASSIC PURSUIT, unplaced, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding

offence was involved.

An enquiry was held to consider interference in the closing stages when the winner PADDY POWER, ridden by Paul Hanagan, interfered with PRESIDENTIAL (IRE), placed second, ridden by Tony Hamilton. Hanagan was cautioned for careless riding as he had allowed his mount to drift left taking Hamilton marginally off his intended line.

Following the race, Robert Winston reported that TOOFI (FR), unplaced, hung right.
