#### Race 1 - 1:49pm.

## THE MOULTON NURSERIES NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for LUMACHO (IRE) and JUMRA (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

#### Race 2 - 2:24pm.

THE SKY SPORTS RACING SKY 415 "NEWCOMERS" MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 5) (for horses which have never run) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for AESTHETIC to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Stefano Cherchi reported that TWAYBLADE, unplaced, hung left and Jonny Peate reported that BETTERMENT, unplaced, reared several times as the stalls opened and bronked after leaving the stalls resulting in the filly being very slowly away, becoming detached and losing all chances of being competitive.

#### Race 3 - 2:59pm.

Permission was given for ALBERT CEE (FR) and LORDSHIP to wear a red hood to post.

On the run to the line, LORDSHIP, unplaced, shifted marginally right-handed giving a slight bump to ALBERT CEE (FR), unplaced, which in turn moved MACHO SUN (IRE), unplaced, off it's intended line but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that there was no riding offence involved.

Following the race, Christian Howarth reported that ALBERT CEE (FR) hung left in the closing stages.

## THE AT THE RACES APP MARKET MOVERS MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for BEDOUIN QUEEN and MODAARA to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Robert Havlin reported that WONDERFUL TIMES (IRE), placed third, hung left under pressure. Stevie Donohoe reported that DANCING EMPRESS, unplaced, ran too freely and Louis Steward reported that MYSTIC ROCK (IRE), unplaced, ran green.

#### Race 5 - 4:09pm.

#### THE AT THE RACES APP EXPERT TIPS HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for WESTERN STARS (FR) and THEFASTNTHECURIOUS to wear a red hood to post.

Approximately 1 ½ furlongs out, MUSTAZEED (IRE), placed second, shifted slightly left-handed at the same time as BAKERSBOY, placed third, shifted right-handed causing WESTERN STARS (FR), placed fourth, to be short of room and its rider to take a check but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that there was no riding offence involved and it had not improved the placing of any runner.

## Race 6 - 4:39pm.

### THE NATIONAL HORSERACING MUSEUM SUPPORTED BY ARC HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for NAVY DRUMS (USA) to go early to post and for LITTLE SUNFLOWER to be mounted on the course and go early to post.

Following the race, Nicola Currie reported that BLUE COLLAR LAD, placed second, hung right under pressure. Joey Haynes reported that TILSWORTH TAIBO, unplaced, had no more to give and Cameron Noble reported that HUNDON, unplaced, was slowly away.
