Race 1 - 2:30pm. THE QUEEN ANNE STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 1) (British Champions Series)

Permission was given for REAL WORLD (IRE) to wear a red hood which was removed at the start.

Race 2 - 3:05pm. THE COVENTRY STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 2)

Permission was given for WAITING ALL NIGHT to wear a red hood which was removed at the start.

Hollie Doyle, the rider of the winner, BRADSELL, was suspended for 2 days for using her whip above the permitted level from approaching the final furlong.

Race 3 - 3:40pm. THE KING'S STAND STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 1) (British Champions Series)

Permission was given for EQUILATERAL to go early to post, for EXISTENT to be mounted in the chute, for KHAADEM (IRE) to wear a red hood which was removed at the start and to go early to post, for LAZULI (IRE) to wear a red hood which was removed at the start, for MAN OF PROMISE (USA) to wear a red hood which was removed at the start, for MONDAMMEJ to go early to post, for NATURE STRIP (AUS) to wear a red hood which was removed at the start, and for GOLDEN PAL (USA) to be ponied to the start. WINTER POWER (IRE) wore earplugs which were removed at the start.

GOLDEN PAL (USA), trained by Wesley Ward, NATURE STRIP, trained by Chris Waller, and LAZULI (IRE) and MAN OF PROMISE (USA), both trained by Charlie Appleby, had entered the Parade Ring after the signal to mount had been given. After being interviewed, all three trainers were fined £1000.

The Starter reported that MONDAMMEJ refused to enter stalls. Antony Britain was informed that the gelding could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

An enquiry was held into the start and the possible withdrawal of KHAADEM (IRE), ridden by Jamie Spencer. The rider and the Starter were interviewed and shown recordings of the start. It was found that KHAADEM (IRE) was deemed not to have started as the gelding had sat down on his haunches fractionally before the start was effected causing Spencer to have to sit on the back gate. As such, as Spencer was not mounted as the start was effected, KHAADEM (IRE) was withdrawn.

Following the race, Irad Ortiz Jr reported that GOLDEN PAL (USA), unplaced, was slowly away.

Race 4 - 4:20pm. THE ST JAMES'S PALACE STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 1) (British Champions Series)

Permission was given for ANGEL BLEU (FR), LIGHT INFANTRY (FR), MIGHTY ULYSEES, and NEW ENERGY (IRE) to wear red hoods which were removed at the start.





Pat Dobbs the rider of LUSAIL (IRE), placed second, was suspended for 4 days for using his whip in the incorrect place inside the final half furlong.

Following the race, Cieren Fallon reported that MALJOOM (IRE), placed fourth, was denied a clear run approximately one and a half furlongs out.

Race 5 - 5:00pm. THE ASCOT STAKES (CLASS 2) (Heritage Handicap)

Permission was given for THEMAXWECAN (IRE) to go early to post and be mounted in the chute, for PIED PIPER and GOING GONE (IRE) to wear red hoods which were removed at the start, for JUST HUBERT (IRE) to go early to post, to wear a red hood which was removed at the start; the gelding also wore earplugs.

It was noted that JUST HUBERT (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Nicola Currie, ducked quickly left-handed on the first bend whilst in the lead, before re-joining the rear of the field.

Approximately two furlongs out the winner, COLTRANE (IRE), moved marginally left for a run at the same time as TRIBAL ART (IRE), unplaced, shifted right-handed, causing them to make contact, but after viewing a recording of the incident it was found that no riding offence was involved and it had not improved the placing of COLTRANE (IRE).

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination during routine testing of MARSHALL PLAN, which was pulled up, revealed the colt was showing signs of heat stress. The Veterinary Officer further reported that SURREY GOLD (IRE), which was pulled up, had an irregular heartbeat and was showing signs of heat stress.

Race 6 - 5:35pm.

THE WOLFERTON STAKES (CLASS 1) (Listed Race)

Permission was given for both CADILLAC (IRE) and STAR SAFARI to wear a red hood which was removed at the start.

Following the race, Hollie Doyle reported that CERTAIN LAD, unplaced, anticipated the start, and Jack Mitchell reported that MOVIN TIME, unplaced, was slowly away.

Race 7 - 6:10pm. THE COPPER HORSE STAKES (CLASS 2 HANDICAP)

An enquiry was held to consider interference approximately one and a half furlongs out involving DANEHILL KODIAC (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Sean Levey, the winner, GET SHIRTY (IRE), ridden by Daniel Tudhope, and QUENELLE D'OR, placed fifth, ridden by James Doyle. The interference was found to accidental as QUENELLE D'OR had shifted quickly right-handed away from the whip before being corrected making contact with GET SHIRTY (IRE) shifting it off its intended line and leaving QUENELLE





D'OR short of room against the rail.

Approaching the final furlong STOWELL, unplaced, shifted quickly right-handed away from the whip before being quickly corrected causing the rider of JUAN DE MONTALBAN (IRE), unplaced, to have to take a check, but after viewing a recording of the incident it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, David Probert reported that ALOUNAK (FR), unplaced, moved poorly.
