were satisfied that racing could commence.

Due to standing water, in Race 4, over the round mile, permission was given for the stalls position to be moved 40 yards forward from the advertised position and located on the

outside.

THE ALBANY STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 3)

Following the race, Simon Crisford reported that FLOTUS (IRE), unplaced, was unsuited by the Heavy ground and would prefer a quicker surface.

Race 2 - 3:05pm.

THE KING EDWARD VII STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 2)

Race 3 - 3:40pm.

THE COMMONWEALTH CUP (CLASS 1) (Group 1) (British Champions Series)

Permission was given for CAMPANELLE (IRE) to be ponied to the start.

An enquiry was held to consider the placings in this race following interference over the final furlong and a half when the winner, DRAGON SYMBOL, ridden by Oisin Murphy, interfered with CAMPANELLE (IRE), placed second, ridden by Frankie Dettori. The Stewards considered that the interference had improved DRAGON SYMBOL's placing as at the time of interference, both horses were travelling equally as well, and they believed that the distance lost by CAMPANELLE (IRE) who was taken notably off her intended line and bumped on a minimum of two occasions, equated to more than the head by which she was beaten. Murphy was suspended for 4 days for careless riding for allowing his mount to hang right-handed for a sustained period without sufficient correction, making contact with CAMPANELLE (IRE) on a couple of occasions and causing her to be taken notably off her intended line. They ordered the placings to be revised as follows: CAMPANELLE (IRE), first, DRAGON SYMBOL, second.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that A CASE OF YOU (IRE), unplaced, had lost its right-fore shoe.

Race 4 - 4:20pm.

THE CORONATION STAKES (CLASS 1) (Group 1) (British Champions Series)





Due to the ground conditions, permission was given for the Parade to be cancelled for The Coronation Stakes.

Permission was given for ALCOHOL FREE (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

Race 5 - 5:00pm.

THE SANDRINGHAM STAKES (CLASS 2 HANDICAP)

Permission was given for both A'SHAARI and MIRAGE MAC to wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, Thady Gosden reported that KESTENNA and STAR OF EMARAATY (IRE), both unplaced, were unsuited by the Heavy ground and would prefer a quicker surface.

Race 6 - 5:35pm.

THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH STAKES (CLASS 2 HANDICAP)

FAVORITE MOON (GER) wore earplugs.

Following the race, Hector Crouch reported that SAM COOKE (IRE), unplaced, ran too free, and Hollie Doyle reported that SCARLET DRAGON, unplaced, ran too free.

Race 7 - 6:10pm.

THE PALACE OF HOLYROODHOUSE STAKES (CLASS 2 HANDICAP)

Permission was given for BEDFORD FLYER (IRE) to wear a hood in the Parade Ring and go early to post, for SIGNIFICANTLY to wear a red hood to the start, for DENSE STAR (IRE) to be mounted in the chute, and for DESERT GULF to go early and wear a red hood to the start.

HALA HALA (IRE), trained by Kevin Ryan, did not enter the Parade Ring due to the trainer having trouble fitting the tongue tie.

The Starter reported SIGNIFICANTLY was the subject of a third criteria failure. Karl Burke was informed that the colt could not run until the day after passing a stalls test. As it was the second occasion within the previous 12 months that SIGNIFICANTLY had been reported, a further report within the same period would mean the colt would be prevented from having a stalls test for 6 months.

Following the race, the representative of Michael Appleby reported that WARRIOR BRAVE, unplaced, was unsuited by the Heavy ground and would prefer a quicker surface. Ben Curtis reported that REBEL AT DAWN (IRE), placed sixth, hung badly left-handed, Oisin Murphy reported that MO CELITA (IRE), placed fifth, hung left-handed under pressure, and Cieren Fallon reported that SHALAA ASKER, unplaced, hung left-handed under pressure.
