Race 1 - 2:00pm. THE EBF FILLIES' NOVICE STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for BLUE EYED KATE (IRE) to wear a red hood to post. RARE JEWEL wore earplugs which were removed at the start.

Race 2 - 2:30pm. THE BEVERLEY RACECOURSE SCULPTURE TRAIL NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for REGAL SOLITAIRE to wear a red hood post.

RIVERVIEW LAW, drawn 3, jumped markedly left-handed upon leaving the stalls giving CHARLIE MASON, drawn 4, a hefty bump, but after viewing a recording of the incident it was found that no riding offence was involved.





Race 3 - 3:00pm. THE HAPPY RETIREMENT ANNE DUNN NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

An enquiry was held to consider interference on the bend turning into the home straight involving SURFACE TO AIR (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Phil Dennis, and BRANDAISY, placed fifth, ridden by Cam Hardie. The interference was found to be accidental as the very free running SURFACE TO AIR (IRE) locked on, got hold of the bridle and edged right-handed; as a consequence BRANDAISY was left tight for room, became unbalanced, clipped a heel and stumbled.

Following the race, Phil Dennis reported that SURFACE TO AIR (IRE), unplaced, ran too free, and Cam Hardie reported that BRANDAISY, placed fifth, ran too free.

<u>Race 4 - 3:30pm.</u> THE ROBIN AND WENDY ADAMS 40TH ANNIVERSARY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for SUN POWER (IRE) and INDIAN SOUNDS (IRE) to go early to post, and for CRYPTO QUEST (IRE) to go early to post wearing a red hood.

Shortly after leaving the stalls, RESILIENCE, unplaced, hung quickly right-handed causing INDIAN SOUNDS (IRE), unplaced, to be shifted right-handed which in turn left SUN POWER (FR), unplaced, short for room and checked by the rider, and consequently KING OF TONGA (IRE), unplaced, was caught on heels and also checked by the rider. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Approximately half a furlong out TEXAS MAN (IRE), unplaced, shifted quickly left-handed causing the rider of RESILIENCE, unplaced, to take a precautionary check, but after viewing a recording of the incident it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, Cam Hardie reported that SUN POWER (FR), unplaced, suffered interference shortly after leaving the stalls, and Ben Curtis reported that DANDY SPIRIT (IRE), unplaced, stumbled leaving the stalls and was slowly away as a result.

Race 5 - 4:00pm. THE CHURCHILL TYRES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

COLD HENRY, drawn 2, ridden by Joanna Mason, had originally entered the wrong stall. Being satisfied that this was due to stalls handler error and was immediately corrected, no further action was taken.

Race 6 - 4:30pm. THE A LITTLE BIT OF BEV HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for SHE'S GOT BOTTLE to wear a red hood to post.
