Race 1 - 1:45pm.

THE AT THE RACES APP MARKET MOVERS NURSERY HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for SEARCH to wear a red hood to the start.

BIRKIE BOY (IRE) unseated Olivia Tubb in the Parade Ring. Having been checked by the Doctor at the start, Tubbs was deemed fit to race.

Race 2 - 2:20pm.

THE AT THE RACES APP FORM STUDY EBF RESTRICTED MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 4) (for horses in Bands C and D) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for FERNDEN WELLS (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

Race 3 - 2:55pm.

THE SKY SPORTS RACING SKY 415 APPRENTICE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6) (Hands and Heels Race) (Part of the Racing Excellence Series)

Permission was given for CONTROL to wear a red hood to the start.

The Clerk of the Scales objected to CONTROL, ridden by Molly Presland, and trained by John Butler, on the grounds of the rider weighing in at 7st 13lbs, having weighed out at 9st 12lbs. The rider, the representative of the trainer and the Clerk of the Scales were interviewed. Presland's explanation that her weight cloth had fallen off approximately 2 furlongs was accepted. CONTROL was disqualified and the placings were revised as follows: First – TEMUR KHAN, Second – ALODIA, Third – BROAD APPEAL and Fourth – CLOUDY ROSE.

Tommie Jakes, the rider of LADY CLEMMIE, placed fifth, had appeared to use his whip contrary to the Conditions of the race. Jakes was accompanied in the enquiry by a BHA Jockey Coach. After being interviewed and shown recordings of the incident, Jakes was suspended for 7 days for improper riding.

Race 4 - 3:30pm.

THE FREE TIPS DAILY ON attheraces.com HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for STORM VALLEY to wear a red hood to the start.

Following the race, Owen Lewis reported that JACKIE DIAMOND, unplaced, hung badly left-handed.

Race 5 - 4:05pm.

THE CHAMPIONS DAY ON SKY SPORTS RACING EBF RESTRICTED MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 5) (for horses in Band D which have had no more than three runs) (GBB RACE)

Turning into the home straight a free running PROMETEO, placed second, clipped the heels of MYSTERIOUS SOUL (IRE), placed third, causing the colt to stumble. However, after viewing a recording of the incident it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of PROMETEO.



Following the race, Neil Callan reported that PROMETEO, placed second, ran too free.

Race 6 - 4:40pm.

THE SKY SPORTS RACING HD VIRGIN 519 HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for STYLE OF LIFE (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start and for SILVER DIVA to go early to post.

Following the race, Saffie Osborne reported that STYLE OF LIFE (IRE), unplaced, ran too free. Paddy Bradley reported that EDMUND IRONSIDE, unplaced, hung left-handed inside the final 2 furlongs. Darragh Keenan reported that SILVER DIVA, unplaced, hung right-handed.

Race 7 - 5:15pm.

THE DOWNLOAD THE AT THE RACES APP HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 6)

Permission was given for PUFFABLE to go early wearing a red hood to the start.

The Starter reported that STREET PARADE was reluctant to load. Michael Attwater was informed that the gelding could not run until the day after passing a stalls test.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approaching the cut away involving PUFFABLE, unplaced, ridden by Tommie Jakes and the winner, BATCHELOR BOY (IRE), ridden by Darragh Keenan. Being a 7lb claimer, Jakes was offered the opportunity to be accompanied in the enquiry but declined. Keenan was suspended for 2 days for careless riding as he allowed his mount to shift left-handed towards the rail when insufficiently clear of PUFFABLE causing Jakes to take a check when tightened for room against the rail.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approximately ½ furlong out involving ATTY'S EDGE, placed fifth, ridden by William Cox and STREET PARADE, placed, third, ridden by William Carson. The interference was found to be accidental as STREET PARADE shifted quickly left-handed at the same time as ATTY'S EDGE stepped right-handed resulting in Cox taking a precautionary check.

Entering the first bend a free running PUFFABLE, unplaced, made contact with the running rail at the point of the bend causing the filly to become briefly unbalanced. However, after viewing a recording of the incident it was found that no riding offence was involved.

The performance of CUBAN GREY, which finished last of seven runners beaten 8 ½ lengths, was considered. The explanation given by the representative of Michael Murphy and Keady that the gelding made a respiratory noise.
