<u>Race 1 - 1:25pm.</u> THE PERTEMPS NETWORK MAIDEN HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for ARCTIC BLUE to go early wearing a red hood to the start and to be mounted in the chute; for KAPAL LAYAR (IRE) to wear a red hood to the start.

Shortly after the start PURE BLUE (IRE), unplaced, lugged slightly right-handed crowding RUBY'S LEGACY, which was later pulled up, onto FIVE QUARTERS (IRE), placed third, which had to be checked





by its rider. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding was involved.

Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that PURE BLUE (IRE), unplaced, finished lame on its left-fore. The Veterinary Officer further reported that NIL VERT (FR), unplaced, had lost its right-fore shoe.
