THE WATCH RACINGTV WITH FREE TRIAL NOW JUVENILE HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Race 2 - 12:33pm.

THE 100% RACINGTV PROFITS BACK TO RACING NOVICES' STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 3) (GBB RACE)

The performance of THE WOLF (FR), which started second favourite and finished fifth, was considered. The representative of Olly Murphy's explanation that the gelding made a mistake at the thirteenth fence and was never travelling thereafter, was noted. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of THE WOLF, during routine testing, revealed the gelding sustained a wound to its right-hind.

Race 3 - 1:03pm.

THE START YOUR RACINGTV FREE TRIAL NOW MARES' NOVICES' HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Sam Twiston-Davies, the rider of WHO TOLD YOU, had fallen approaching the sixth-last hurdle. The rider was interviewed and shown recordings of the incident. It was found that no other horse or rider was involved and caused by WHO TOLD YOU taking a false step, stumbling and falling, causing Twiston-Davies to fall from the mare. The Veterinary Officer subsequently reported that a post-race examination revealed the mare to be lame on its left-fore.

Following the race, Lorcan Williams reported that GIO'S GIRL, placed second, hung left-handed and David Noonan reported that LIGHTNING GOLD, which was pulled up, hung left-handed from halfway.

Race 4 - 1:33pm.

THE WATCH RACING TV IN STUNNING HD HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 3)

RATHLIN ROSE (IRE) wore earplugs which were removed at the start.

Following the race, Sam Twiston-Davies reported that LUCKOFTHEDRAW (FR), which was pulled up, made a bad mistake at the fifth-last fence and was never travelling thereafter.

Race 5 - 2:08pm.

THE RACING TV HD ON SKY 426 HANDICAP STEEPLE CHASE (CLASS 3)

Tom Symonds was fined £290 for failing to notify the Racing Calendar Office that SAINT DE VASSY (FR) had undergone Wind Surgery until after the horse had been declared to run.

FOLLY GATE (FR) wore earplugs throughout the race.

NIGHT OF SIN (FR) made contact with the rails when exiting the Parade Ring to go onto the course.





Having been examined by the Veterinary Surgeon at the start, the gelding was deemed fit to race.

The performance of NIGHT OF SIN (FR), which started second favourite and was pulled up, was considered. Nick Williams could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance other than NIGHT OF SIN (FR) never appeared to be travelling on this occasion.

Race 6 - 2:43pm.

THE FOLLOW @racingtv ON INSTAGRAM HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 4)

SOME SPIN (IRE) wore earplugs throughout the race.

The performance of GETABUCK (IRE), which finished sixth, beaten by 20½ lengths, was considered. The representative of Ali Stronge's explanation that the gelding was unsuited by the ground, which was officially described as Soft on this occasion and would prefer a faster surface, was noted.

The performance of COBRA ANGEL (IRE), which started second favourite and finished unplaced, beaten by 40 lengths, was considered. Chris Down could offer no explanation for the mare's performance.

Race 7 - 3:18pm.

THE racingtv.com/freemonth HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 5) (DIV I)

MOTTS CROSS (IRE), trained by Chris Down, had arrived in the Parade Ring without its declared cheekpieces, which were then located and fitted on the gelding before going to the start. After being interviewed, Down was cautioned.

The apparent improvement in form of the winner, POUR UNE RAISON (FR), which had never previously been placed, was considered. Richard Mitchell was interviewed. His comments that POUR UNE RAISON (FR) had been hampered approaching the first flight on its previous run and was never travelling thereafter, whereas on this occasion the gelding had an uninterrupted run was noted. POUR UNE RAISON (FR) was routine tested.

Following the race, Page Fuller reported that DREAM DE DREAM (IRE), which was pulled up, stopped quickly.

Race 8 - 3:53pm.

THE racingtv.com/freemonth HANDICAP HURDLE RACE (CLASS 5) (DIV II)

AFTER THE FOX wore earplugs which were removed at the start.

Ciaran Gethings, the rider of AFTER THE FOX, had fallen rounding the home bend. The rider was interviewed and shown recordings of the incident. It was found that no other horse or rider was involved and was caused by the gelding stumbling on the bend and falling, resulting in FLOU ARTSISTIQUE (FR), placed fifth, and KALABEE (IRE), placed sixth, both being significantly hampered.

Following the race, Joe Anderson reported that ARCTIC FOOTPRINT, placed seventh, stopped quickly;





Chris Down reported that the mare made a respiratory noise. James Bowen reported that HEPBURN, which was pulled up, made a mistake at the first hurdle in the back straight and Lorcan Williams reported that THIRSTY FARMER, placed fourth, hung right-handed.
