Permission was given for HUDDLE UP (IRE) to go early to post; for WOOBAY (IRE) and RORY to both wear a red hood to post.

THE ARMOUR HOME IMPROVEMENTS EBF MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 5) (GBB RACE)

Alice Haynes had obtained prior permission from the BHA to run HELAALI (IRE) partially shod.

Race 3 - 3:35pm.

THE BOOK FOR SCOTTISH SUN LADIES NIGHT CLASSIFIED STAKES (CLASS 6)

Approaching ½ furlong out, HAALIM, placed second, hung right-handed, causing COCONUT BAY, placed third, to ease slightly, but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of HAALIM.

The winner, WHERE'S THE CRUMPET, appeared to show improved form compared with its previous run at Newcastle on 28 June 2024 where the mare finished ninth of 11 runners, beaten by 12 ¾ lengths. David Thompson's explanation that the mare was better suited by being ridden more prominently on this occasion was noted. WHERE'S THE CRUMPET was routine tested.

Following the race, Mohammed Tabti reported that LOOM LARGE (IRE), unplaced, slipped on the bend turning into the home straight.

Approaching the final 2 furlongs, ROYAL COUNTESS, unplaced, shifted marginally right-handed, moving REVEAL, placed fourth, off its intended line, which in turn, moved BRAES OF DOUNE, placed third, off its intended line and in turn, bumped the winner, DINGWALL, causing it to be moved off its intended line but after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved.

Following the race, Paul Mulrennan reported that BRAES OF DOUNE, placed third, slipped leaving the stalls.
