Race 1 - 5:20pm.

THE BACK TO GOODWOOD HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 3)

Permission was given for C'EST NO MOUR (GER) to wear a hood in the parade ring which was removed before going to the start.

Following the race, David Simcock reported that ISPAHAN, placed fifth of five, was unsuited by the Good to Firm, Good in places ground on this occasion and would prefer a slower surface.

Race 2 - 5:50pm.

THE SOUTH DOWNS WATER FILLIES' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for PEARL BEACH to wear a hood in the parade ring which was removed before going to the start.

Prior to this race, a query was raised with David Elsworth as to why he was running END RESULT here at Goodwood on going described as Good to Firm, Good in places, having declared the filly a non-runner at Doncaster on 5 June 2021 on ground with the same official description. The trainer stated that in his opinion the track at Doncaster has had a lot of racing, and whilst it is not ideal to run the filly on this ground at Goodwood, he wanted her to take her chance today as he felt the track was well watered and has had much less racing recently.

Race 3 - 6:25pm.

THE GOODWOOD RACEHORSE OWNERS' GROUP HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for ADDOSH to be mounted in the chute.





Following the race, the Veterinary Officer reported that UNCLE DICK, placed third, lost both front shoes, and that AMBARELLA (IRE), placed seventh, lost its right hind shoe.

Race 4 - 7:00pm.

THE CHARLTON HUNT FILLIES' HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 5)

Permission was given for GIVE 'EM THE SLIP to wear a red hood in the preliminaries which was removed at the start, for LIBERTY BAY to go to post early, and for LIBERTINE BELLE to be mounted in the chute.

The raceday privilege request in relation to LIBERTY BAY, trained by Mark Usher, was not submitted correctly. Usher was warned as to his responsibility to ensure that all raceday privilege requests are submitted online before 1pm on the day before racing.

Race 5 - 7:35pm.

THE SIR ERIC PARKER MEMORIAL EBF RESTRICTED MAIDEN FILLIES' STAKES (CLASS 4) (for horses in Bands B, C and D) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for BANSHEE (IRE) to wear a red hood in the preliminaries which was removed at the start.

The performance of PRISM (IRE) which started favourite but finished unplaced, was considered. The representative of Roger Varian explained that the filly became upset in the preliminaries and was restless in the stalls. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of PRISM during routine testing failed to reveal any abnormalities.

Race 6 - 8:10pm.

THE SILK SERIES HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4) (For Pro-Am Female Jockeys)

Permission was given for EPIC PASS (IRE) to be mounted in the chute and go to post early.

Half a furlong out, BUG BOY (IRE), placed second, shifted quickly right from the whip giving a slight bump to RAFIOT (USA), placed fourth. However, after viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of BUG BOY (IRE).

An enquiry was held to consider interference inside the final ½ furlong when the winner GENESIUS (IRE), ridden by Morgan Cole, interfered with ZUBA, placed third, ridden by Laura Pearson, and EPIC PASS (IRE), placed fifth, ridden by Jane Elliott. Cole was suspended for 2 days for careless riding as she had failed to take sufficient steps to prevent her mount from drifting right, moving GENESUIS (IRE) and EPIC PASS (IRE) off their intended lines.

Following the race, Georgia Cox reported that JAZZ PARTY, unplaced, hung left and moved poorly throughout. Katherine Begley reported that FROZEN WATERS (IRE), placed seventh, jumped awkwardly out the stalls and was slowly into stride.
