#### Race 1 - 5:12pm. THE WILLIAM HILL KEEP YOUR RACEDAY POSITIVE MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Permission was given for MANALI (IRE) to go early and wear a red hood to post.

Approximately one furlong out, SENNOCKIAN (IRE), placed second, edged right-handed causing the winner, NOTTA NOTHER, to be shifted slightly off its intended line, which in turn gave a small bump to RAINYNITEINGEORGIA (IRE), placed fourth, who became unbalanced. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of SENNOCKIAN (IRE) or NOTTA NOTHER.

#### Race 2 - 5:47pm. THE WILLIAM HILL EPIC BOOST HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for SOVEREIGN SPIRIT to wear a red hood to post.

The performance of IT'S ALL ABOUT YOU (IRE) which finished seventh of seven, beaten 23 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> lengths, was considered. Harry Charlton reported that IT'S ALL ABOUT YOU (IRE) was never travelling. The Veterinary Officer reported that a post-race examination of the colt, failed to reveal any abnormalities.

# THE RACING WITH PRIDE HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for STAR CALIBER to go early to post.

An enquiry was held to consider interference approximately one furlong out, involving ANDALEEP (IRE), placed second, ridden by Rhys Clutterbuck; LADY RESET, placed fourth, ridden by Gina Mangan and ENTHRALLMENT (IRE), unplaced, ridden by Paddy Bradley. Clutterbuck was cautioned for careless riding as he allowed his horse to shift right-handed without sufficient correction, taking LADY RESET slightly off her intended line which in turn caused the rider of ENTHRALLMENT (IRE) to take a slight check.

Following the race, Tom Queally reported that STAR CALIBER, unplaced, ran too free.

## Race 4 - 6:55pm. THE WILLIAM HILL PRESENTS UP FRONT HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for HUBERTS DREAM (IRE) to be mounted in the chute.

### Race 5 - 7:30pm.

### THE NICHOLSON GIN MAIDEN STAKES (CLASS 4) (GBB RACE)

Inside the 2 furlong marker, the winner, MIDNIGHT LION shifted quickly left-handed away from the whip taking ART DE VIVRE, placed second, slightly off its intended line. After viewing a recording of the incident, it was found that no riding offence was involved and that it had not improved the placing of MIDNIGHT LION.

Following the race, George Bass reported that A TICKATICKATIMING, unplaced, reared leaving the stalls and the representative of Andrew Balding reported that ANOTHER RUN (IRE), placed fourth, was unsuited by the ground described as Good, Good to Firm in places and would prefer a slower surface.

### Race 6 - 8:05pm.

# THE WILLIAM HILL HANDICAP STAKES (CLASS 4)

Permission was given for HALLA DUBAI (IRE) to wear a red hood to post.

Following the race, Pat Dobbs reported that MINDTHEGAP (IRE), placed fifth, hung left-handed; David Probert reported that HALLA DUBAI (IRE), placed fourth, ran too free; Pat Cosgrave reported that NAILS MURPHY (IRE), placed second, ran too free and Alec Voikhansky reported that SEDUCTIVE POWER (IRE), unplaced, ran too free.
