	Chase Race: Good to Soft (GSt 5.1)
	Hurdle Course
	Hurdle Race: Good to Soft (Good in places) (GSt 5.6)
Rail:	Bends: Separate stable bends, each bend is out 11 yds from innermost line, adds 35yds per circuit. Shared hurdle east bend, out 12yds from innermost line, adds 38yds for hurdle, minus 54yds for chase per circuit. Obstacles: Three back-straight hurdles in central positions, out 5-7yds from innermost line. The last hurdle in the home straight remains in its 'forward position' 146yds from the winning line, therefore 13 obstacles will be jumped in a 3m hurdle race. Ground repair: Recovery has been slow since our last raceday, the track has had a roll repair to level out the surface. The obstacle positions and bend configurations offer the best available ground, the East Bend is entirely fresh.
